The glossary is comprehensive but assumes the reader already has a copy of *Gerlyver Kescows – A Cornish Dictionary for Conversation* (Ian Jackson, Agan Tavas 2017). The format and abbreviations are the same as in that book. Generally speaking, definitions have been confined to those relevant to the story. Words and phrases that may be found in *Gerlyver Kescows* are not repeated, except to indicate a specific additional meaning. If you need grammar, by far the best book is *Desky Kernowek* (Nicholas Williams, Evertype 2012).
