Variation application to condition 7 of planning consent 340429 (Wokingham Borough Council) and 426466 (The Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead)(granted on appeal on 05/09/1994) in order to extend the time for the deposit of non-inert waste from 17 years from the date upon which the deposit operations commenced to 20 years, to extend the time for the deposit of engineering/restoration materials (inert waste) from 17 years from the date upon which the deposit operations commenced to 21 years, and to extend the time for the completion of the site's restoration from 19 years from the date upon which the deposit operations commenced to 22 years.	Whilst Hurley Parish Council is not supporting or objecting to these applications, the Parish would like to comment that at a recent public meeting of local residents the consensus of opinion was that they should be refused and that the operating company should withdraw from the site at the earliest opportunity. If the applications are approved, the Parish would urge that the site be appropriately policed/monitored by Wokingham Borough Council and the Environment Agency, to ensure compliance with all conditions.

The Parish Council objects to the proposal as they consider it to be overdevelopment of the site, un-neighbourly, would result in overlooking into the interiors of neighbouring properties and does not have adequate access and parking. If approved, the Parish Council would also like to highlight the concerns of neighbouring landowners in relation to access and parking during construction.
