

Navy JROTC is a leadership, community service and citizenship development program. Cadets are required to perform extra duties across the semester in keeping with the core curriculum. Examples cadets should participate in include teams, participation (ex...field trips) and/or unit service events (ex...openhouse, competition assistance). They are expected to be dressed in the correct uniform on the assigned day and be on-time and prepared for class each day.

The Program Aptitude / Service grade is 8% and is broken down as follows:
