

Visa basic regulations

Single Entry visa valid for 1 month	40.00 JOD (= 56.41 USD)
Double entry visa valid for 3 months	60.00 JOD (= 84.62 USD)
Multiple entries visa valid for 6 months	120.00 JOD (=169.25 USD)

- 1) The one entry can be taken at airports upon arrival unless special regulation (restricted nationality, stay shorter than 2 consecutive nights) and must be paid in JOD.
- 2) Children must carry a separate passport.
- 3) The *Jordan Pass* includes a visa with the main sites entrance fees, on the condition to spend a minimum of 3 consecutive nights in Jordan. It must be purchased online before arrival. The *Jordan Pass* is valid for 2 weeks of the first tourist attraction visit. For more information: <https://www.jordanpass.jo/>
- 4) Exempted for paying visa fees:
 - Individuals or groups of non-restricted nationalities coming through a Jordanian Tour Operator, on the condition of spending a minimum of two consecutive nights in Jordan.
 - Citizens from Algeria, Morocco (if younger than 18 years and older than 35 years old), Sudan, Egypt, UAE, Bahrain, KSA, Syria, Palestine, Qatar, Kuwait, Lebanon, Yemen, Japan, Malaysia, Turkey.
 - UN collaborators.
- 5) Some nationalities are restricted and are subject to procedure at the Jordanian representation of the origin country prior arrival. For list, see <http://in.visitjordan.com/generalinformation/entryintojordan.aspx>
- 6) The entry points of Allenby Bridge (=King Hussein Bridge) and ASEZA (Araba crossing and port) are subject to special procedures.
