### **Stop and Search**

Stop and Search is a valuable tool for detecting and deterring crime if used correctly. All searches are supervised and it is now policy that these searches are video recorded unless certain exceptions arise.


### What's been happening in the area

### **Dangerous Dogs**

PC Diskaya was investigating a dangerous dog believed to be a pitbull, which had attacked a smaller dog PC Diskaya applied for a warrant and seized the dangerous dog. The smaller Dog has now recovered from the traumatic experience.

### **Immigration Arrests**

Officers took part in a drugs warrant on Shadwell with immigration officers, only to find 21 people living at address in a unregistered multi home occupancy 19 people were home and 6 people were arrested for immigration offences.
