Stop and Search

Stop and Search is a valuable tool for detecting and deterring crime if used correctly. All searches are supervised and it is now policy that these searches are video recorded unless certain exceptions arise. Central East area is the third highest area in London for police using their search powers correctly with 6.0% for April 2020. Of those searched, 23.9% were arrested, charged or had a positive outcome.

What's been happening in your Area
Due to information that the team was given, we
have completed the below in your area:

Four Fixed Penalty Notices for breach of lock-down restrictions were issued in Wapping in April 2020 by the SNT team. SNT Officers have upped their patrols to frequently attend parks, riverfront walks, and other nature areas, including Shadwell Basin (pictured below, empty, 07/04/2020). Officers firstly engaged and explained to those breaching lockdown restrictions that they must follow the guidelines to ensure everyone's safety, but those who have repeatedly breached lockdown guidelines have been issued fines to deter them from continuing to breach the lockdown.



Officers have engaged with rough sleepers in St Katharine's and Wapping and neighbouring wards of Shadwell and Whitechapel, contacting Streetlink and outreach teams to provide assistance during these unprecedented times. If you encounter someone rough-sleeping, call Streetlink on 0300 500 0914 to report them to local outreach teams who are equipped to provide assistance.

Three Ward Priorities for your Area

1. ASP

We aim to tackle this by issuing Community Protection Notices to repeat offenders of Anti-Social Behaviour, which allows us to put conditions on their behaviours, possibly leading to fines and remedial orders.

2. Traffic/Vehicular Nuisance

We aim to tackle this by providing residents with information regarding reporting practices, aiding us in seizing vehicles engaged in Anti-Social Behaviour.

3. Drugs

The above two methods will assist us in disrupting behaviours that aid in the supply of drugs.

Burglary Advice

- 1. Low front boundary
- 2. Secure side gate and keep locked at all times.
- 3. High side and rear boundaries
- 4. Gravel driveway and path
- 5. Security lights
- 6. Intruder alarm system
- 7. Lock shed door and window
- 8. Never leave tools lying around
