Tower Hamlets is the third highest area in London for police using their search powers with a positive outcome.

What's been happening?

Dispersal Zone

In the wake of Corvid, lockdown and restrictions, we had a number of complaints in regards to increase of Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB). We decided to put a Dispersal Zone in place as part of Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014. This was authorised by an Inspector for most of the ward except anything East of Garnet Street E1.

We patrolled with Tower Hamlets
Enforcement Officers (THEOS) and spoke to many residents explaining what we were doing.
Unfortunately none of main places Hermitage
Gardens, Waterside Gardens, Thomas More Street,
Prussom Street, St Katharine's Way, Wapping High
Street and Wapping Lane E1, had anyone committing any serious ASB. Some people were spoken to explained, a dispersal zone was in place and police and Tower Hamlets officers were patrolling.

Dispersal Zone was in place on Saturday 11th September 2020 at 1800 hours authorised until Sunday 12th September 2020 at 1800 Hours.

Speed Gun Training
