usie and I have been blessed this year and we are writing to you at this year's end to invite you to consider how you have made a difference in the lives of people you'll likely never meet—as well as in us and our family—and to encourage you to give as God leads you at this time. We are grateful to God that you join us on this journey. Your prayers and financial support strengthen our faith in God as we know that He is the true source of all we have. 2018 has brought many challenges that have been met by Him through your faithfulness to us and our call to ministry with FamilyLife. Life change for a lifetime is our passion and desire and God allows us to see the Gospel change many lives through FamilyLife getaways, resources, radio programs and hosted events.

We lead three volunteer teams (Chicago, Tulsa and St. Louis) who invited and coached couples to be engaged using our Weekend to Remember Invitation plan that resulted in over 3000 people attending 4 events in those cities. 74 people indicated that they had accepted Christ as their Lord and Savior at those events! As a ministry we reached over 61,000 people at 95 events and over 1500 individuals—that we know of—indicated a decision for Christ at our events.
