COMMUNICATION AND VISIBILITY

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Main rules

Beneficiaries are requested to give adequate visibility to their projects and notably that they are implemented in the framework of Erasmus+. Any publication should mention the following sentence:

"This project has been funded with support from the European Commission. This publication reflects the views only of the author, and the Commission cannot be held responsible for any use which may be made of the information contained therein."

Material produced for project activities, training material, projects websites, special events, posters, leaflets, press releases, CD ROMs, etc. must bear **HarISA logo**. The use of the HarISA is compulsory. **No changes in color and content are authorized**. The logo should not be distorted, nor rotated.





























Example of correct application

Erasmus+ logo

Beneficiaries of EU funding shall use the **European emblem (EU flag)** in their communication to acknowledge the support received under EU programs.

The minimum height of the EU emblem shall be 10mm.

Next to the EU emblem on the communication material where it is used, a written mention shall be put, referring to the source of funding. The name of the European Union shall always be spelled out in full.



Examples of incorrect application



The name of the EU program can appear with the EU emblem. However, no graphical mark (i.e. logo) shall be created using the EU emblem and name of the program.

Typeface to be used in conjunction with the EU emblem: Arial, Calibri, Garamond, Trebuchet, Tahoma, Verdana.

Italic and underlined variations and the use of font effects are not allowed.

The font size: proportionate to the size of the emblem. The font color: reflex blue (same blue as the EU flag), black or white depending on the background.
