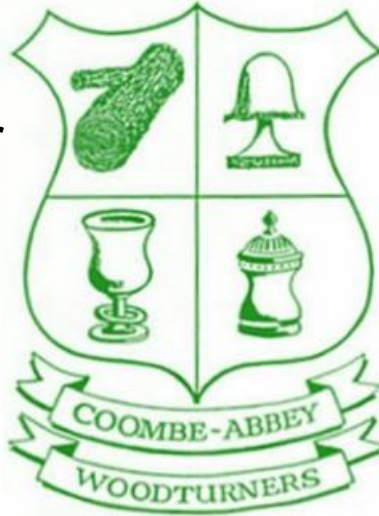

Due to unavoidable problems at home I have not been able to attend as many meetings and events as I would have wished so I do rely on content sent into me for inclusion in the Newsletter.

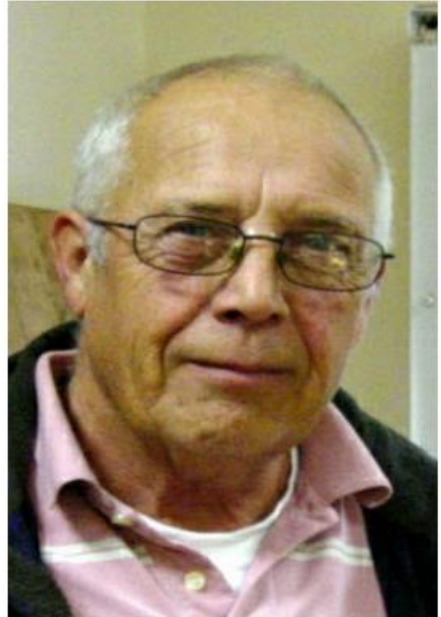
If you have an interesting story or picture that you would care to share with others please let me have it preferably by email but by post or delivered by hand will be most acceptable.

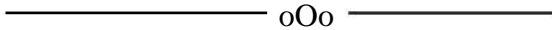


# UK ANNOUNCES NEW 50P COIN TO COMMEMORATE BREXIT

A Demonstration by  
**Paul Bellamy**

At Shilton village hall on Thursday 3rd October 2019

We were treated to a very good demonstration by Paul Bellamy at Shilton and Paul majored on turning without a chuck. (Yes he did have one with him at the start). I remember years ago when my father, a Carpenter by trade made himself a lathe powered by a foot treadle and eventually an electric motor was added. I am not sure but I believe in those days a four jawed chuck had not been

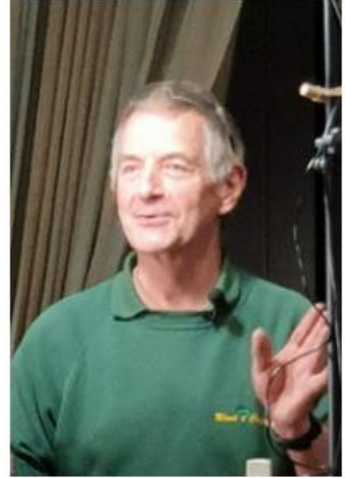


available to buy so it was all either faceplate mounted or the use of a glue chuck. The problem with faceplate mounting

was that the screw holes had to be covered and this was done by gluing baize on the bottom of items such as table lamps etc. Paul adopted both these methods of holding the work to show that if need be we don't need a chuck if we can't afford one.

Paul decided to demonstrate the making of a bowl with stem and base so involving three items to make up his project. Unfortunately I have not got a picture of the finished piece which is a shame as Paul had made a very good job of it.

I am sure that some club members have used Paul's method of using a paper membrane to glue two pieces

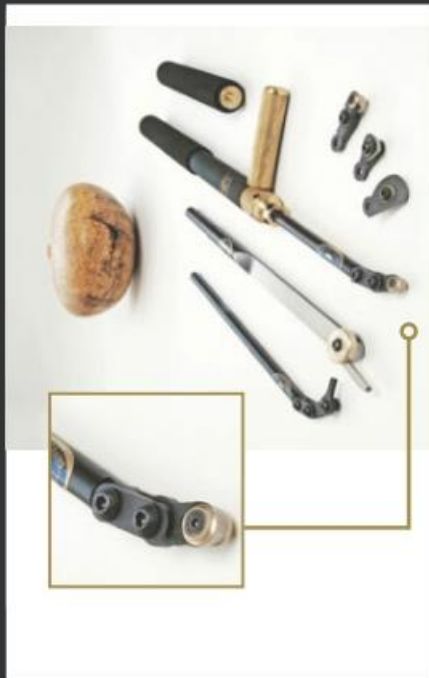

## A Demonstration by Andy Coates

At Walsgrave Baptist Church on Saturday 12th October 2019.

Saturday 12th October, Demo by Andy Coats

The room was slowly filling up, the tables and chairs were out and all we needed now was to fill the seats. The tea was brewed and the bacon batches were cooking, we were all set for the off.



Andy Coates had travelled some miles before he got here. He started with the basics with a difference, of how the wood was structured and explained the grains and end grain and explained the differ-

ent ways of the bowl to be more appropriate to the eye. He turned more and demonstrated how to use more of the wood instead of it being waste on the floor. This was done by cutting out a pyramid then he could use that for other things at a later date.

He then carried out hollowing the rest of the bowl and it was like a cone, then he shaped it into another type of vessel which we have got for next years raffle, all we have to do is sand and seal it. The next one he turned was made up of different types of glued wood together, that's when he explained about the glue he has used and uses, then told us also about the time he glued his finger to his eyelid, which we had a laugh about but understood it must have hurt. As one of our members found out when

using super glue when he put his hand on the tail stock and glued his hand right to it.

Then he produced some wood from Australia and it was very hard which he turned into a small box, which he made the edge rim out of pewter and he then turned this just as you would turn wood. Then he turned the lid which has some blemishes in it. As he turned the lid it split right across from edge to edge, he glued the part that was split then he turned it gently. To Finish

it off he turned a finial out of pewter which he moulded into two cuttle fish, they say seeing is believing and if you missed it well! you missed something good.



In my eyes it was a good demo and those that stayed for half a day or didn't come at all missed out.

## A Useful Tip from Giles Headley.

*Received by email*

Hi Graham

Recently I was showing a friend some of my turned fruit and he noticed a dent in the lemon, which is part of a commission. On this occasion I'd not lost my grip when buffing, so it wasn't caused by flying into the lathe bed, as has happened previously (not recommended, but it keeps everyone in the workshop awake!). Not wanting to re-sand the piece, I got to thinking and the trick used to make an arrow that passes through a goblet came to mind. To achieve it the timber is boiled so it can be temporarily crushed to push it through the hole in the goblet. As it dries the arrowhead takes its original form, which is too big to have fitted!

I balanced the lemon on the spout of my kettle and set it to boil. Having left it there until the steam dissipated I found that the dent had disappeared. All that's needed is a light sanding, re-seal and buff to finish. Then more careful transportation to home and ultimately the client.

## THE MAIL ORDER ABRASIVE SPECIALISTS

Sanding needs as much care as construction and design. As much care needs to be taken in sanding as in the construction of a piece of work. A few minutes poor sanding technique can irreversibly destroy great craftsmanship and many hours work.

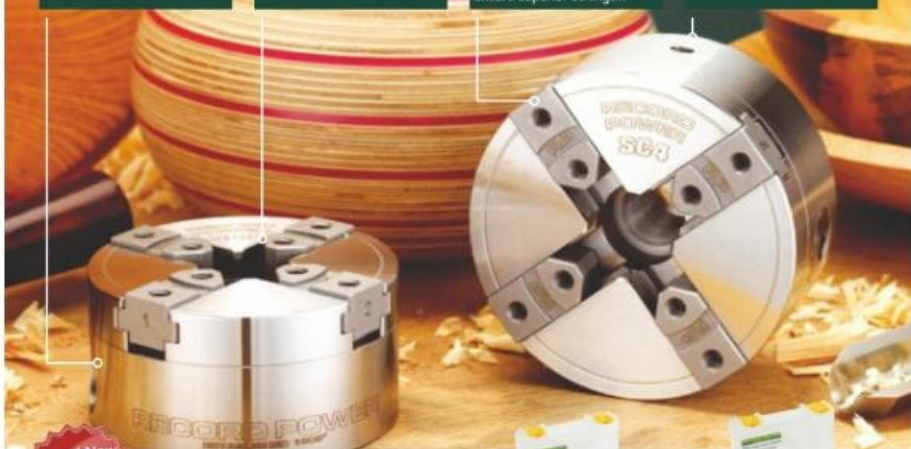
