AFRICA 2000

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

An acrylic emulsion based paint, formulated to provide good performance at an economical price.

PRODUCT FEATURES

AFRICA 2000 was developed to meet the need for a low cost coating, which makes it ideally suited to improving the image of low cost housing, farm boundary walls & other unsightly buildings. AFRICA 2000 is a better option for walls which would normally be painted with white wash.

SURFACE PREPARATION

All surfaces are to be clean, dry & free of oil, grease, dirt & old flaking paint. Should the substrates be powdery or weak, it is recommended to remove as much as possible of the loose powdery surface. Then seal with at least 1 coat of Acrylic Sealer. Allow to dry for 12 hours at 25°C prior to painting with AFRICA 2000.

APPLICATION

Stir contents thoroughly. Use as supplied, do not dilute. 2 Coats recommended. Apply by brush & roller, as supplied. clean up with water. Do not allow to dry on equipment.

ENVIRONMENT

It is recommended that application be confined to the following:

Surface temperature: Min. 15°C Max. 40°C Min. 15°C Max. 40°C Min. 15°C Max. 40°C Min. 15°C Max. 40°C Min. 0% Min. 0% Max. 85%

Or at least 3°C above Dew point

Do not leave container open, as skin forms on the surface of the paint.

OVERCOATING TIMES

15°C: 18 hours 20°C: 12 hours 25°C: 10 hours 30°C: 8 hours

LIMITATIONS

At no time should painting be done in inclement weather or before 9am & after 2pm in winter. Avoid wet weather & wet substrates

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

No known problems resulting from contact with skin, however, remove as soon as possible with soap and water. Avoid ingestion and contact with eyes. If ingested, seek medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. If paint contact is made with eyes, rinse eyes well with water & seek medical attention. Do not smoke when painting.

Ensure good ventilation during painting and drying.
