# Perspectives From your Pastor's heart.....

For the last two months we've been working through a series of sermons dealing with our *walk* as it relates to our relationship with Christ in life. It seems like every week there are new challenges and new perspectives to deal with. Personally, for me it was easier when my *walk* was only about whether to *walk* in the morning before daylight, or to try to squeeze in a few miles before sunset.

There always seem to be so many different things to consider when it comes to a simple **walk**. Footwear is probably top on considerations. You need properly cushioned and treaded footwear to support your feet and your footing based on changing terrain. The second feature of importance is proper attire based on temperatures and personal comfort. For me, the third feature of importance would have to be to have quality music to listen to for focus and enjoyment.



It's amazing how many difference verses and passages in the Bible deal with our walk. Interestingly, little, if anything is said about footwear, attire, or music. Instead, the focus is on HOW we walk, our PERSPECTIVE in our walk. our DIRECTION in our walk. and the QUALITY of our *walk*. For instance, HOW we *walk* is described as being by faith and humbly with our God. Our **PERSPECTIVE** is described as being in newness of life, and no longer as the Gentiles walk. Our DIRECTION is described as being in Him and according to the Spirit. And our **QUALITY** is described as being in love and in the light. It seems like everything changes in our walk based on our focus even before we start the day.

Could it be that our focus is distorted by personal preference, rather than by personal commitment? Could it be that God's intent in adjusting our focus is to get us moving through life with a deeper level of commitment and to get us out of our comfort zone? Could it be that the only way for any of us to grow in our **daily walk** with God is to let go of our personal pleasures and to grab hold of what God wants for us? Could it be that everything can be changed in our **walk with God** if we can simply adjust our focus?

I hope you've made it to worship and been challenged in our *walk* in some way. Don't forget to be working on your **friends** in preparation for our next *Bring-a-friend-day* on Sunday, October 6<sup>th</sup>. See you Sunday with a fresh focus on our *walk*.
