PRESENTATION: All exhibitors are encouraged to attend the presentation in the Roach Pavilion at 12 noon Saturday 21st September.

REGULATIONS:

1. Each fleece should be clearly labeled with the name of the exhibitor and the section and class it is entered in.
2. Any wool received after judging has commenced will be displayed but not judged.
3. A point scorecard system will be used and displayed.
4. All fleeces will be weighed and classified by the Judge.
5. Ram fleeces may compete only in Ram Fleece classes.
6. Hogget fleeces are to be previously unshorn i.e. still have lamb tips.
7. Fleeces to consist of not more than 12 months' growth.
8. The district map is in this schedule.
