Where to take an injured person

If the injured person requires you someone to take them to hospital - The Solent NHS Trust has advised the following procedure

The nearest Walk in Centre is:

Royal South Hants Hospital Graham Road Southampton SO14 0YG 0238071659

This centre is open:

Monday to Friday 7.30am - 10pm Weekends 8am - 10pm When walk in centre is closed take the injured person straight round to A&E at Southampton General Hospital


Walk in Centre's are for fast access to treatment for minor ailments, infections, or injuries such as cuts, strains, sprains and broken bones. This Walk-In Centre now offers x rays on fingers, wrists, forearms, elbows, shoulders, feet, ankles, lower legs or knees to those over 12.

Directions to Royal South Hants Hospital: Sat Navs is: SO14 0YG Distance – 27 Minutes from the ground

- Take a right out of the ground to the end of the road
- Turn right onto the Southampton Road
- After 2 miles take right at roundabout onto A326 towards Totton & Southampton
- After 5.5 miles of straight road Branch left, then at roundabout take the 1st exit onto the A35 signposted Southampton.
- You will go over the roundabout and onto the Totton bypass.
- After you go over the Redbridge flyover you will be on the A33.
- As you come into Southampton City Centre and past the train station keep in the left hand lane.

- Turn left onto the A3024 signposted Ring Road North and East.
- At Charlotte Place roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A335.
- Then at the traffic lights turn left.
- The Royal South Hants Hospital is on the right hand side in Graham Road.



The nearest Accident & Emergency Unit:

If the drop in centre is closed please take the injured person straight round to A&E at Southampton General Hospital



Directions to Southampton General Hospital : Sat Nav is: SO16 6YD Travelling Time : Approx 27 Minutes From The Ground

- Take a right out of the ground to the end of the road
- Turn right onto the Southampton Road
- After 2 miles take right at roundabout onto A326 towards Totton & Southampton
- After 5.5 miles of straight road Branch left, then at roundabout take the 1st exit onto the A35 signposted Southampton.
- You will go over the roundabout and onto the Totton bypass.
- After you go over the Redbridge flyover you will be on the A33.
- You need to branch left and at the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Teboura Way.
- There will be signposts for the Hospital.
- After Tesco you will bear right onto Winchester Road.
- At the traffic signals turn left onto Dale Road
- At mini roundabout turn right onto Tremona Road.

This centre is open:

Everyday 8am – 9pm

When walk in centre is closed take the injured person straight round to A&E at Southampton General Hospital

A minor injury unit is for treatment of such things as cuts, sprains, minor burns or broken bones.

Directions to Lymington New Forest Hospital - Sat Nav is: SO41 8QD Travelling Time: Approx 27 minutes from the ground

- Take a right out of the ground to the end of the road
- Take a left onto Southampton Road
- Follow the road up for a mile past the Croft Pub and then right at the fork
- Keep straight for a mile into & through Dibden Purlieu.
 At roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Beaulieu Road B3054
- At T-junction turn left onto the B3054
- At mini-roundabout branch right, then at mini-roundabout merge onto Marsh Lane - B3054.
- At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A337.
- At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Wellworthy Road.
- Turn left onto Ampress Lane.
- Turn right onto Wellworthy Road.
