

Llanwrtyd Wells Town Council

Report under the Environment (Wales) Act 2016

Llanwrtyd Wells is responsible for Dolwen Field, Town Square and the Memorial Garden	
Any planting to be as diverse as possible and where possible to include native wild species of plant. In turn this will support not only the insect life but also the birds and mammals that feed on them.	
The larger areas of Ecosystems are not managed by the Town Council namely the River Irfon	N/a
To limit the mowing of grass alongside roadways to allow wild flowers and grasses to grow and natural habitats to be maintained.	
Rainwater could be collected from the roofs of the Dolwen Pavilion and the Toilet buildings which could then be used for the watering of plants in the summer months.	
Planting of wild flowers behind Pavilion in Dolwen field whilst unused. Erecting of bat boxes on building.	
Setting up a refill station either in the square or at the toilet block to encourage the re-use of water bottles for walkers and cyclists.	
The installation of bat boxes and bird nesting boxes to encourage usage. Policy to be reviewed annually.
