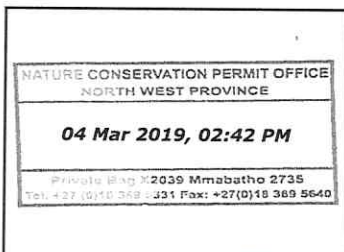

STANDARD CONDITIONS**ALL INTEGRATED PERMIT, STANDING PERMIT & REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE - FAUNA & FLORA**

1) This permit is an "Integrated Permit", as defined of Chapter 1 and issued in terms of Chapter 2, Regulation 4 of the National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act, 2004 (Act 10 of 2004): Threatened or Protected Species Regulations, and; 2) This permit is a "Standing Permit", as defined of Chapter 1 and issued in terms of Chapter 2, Regulation 18 of the National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act, 2004 (Act 10 of 2004): Threatened or Protected Species Regulations, and; 3) This permit is also a "Registration Certificate", as defined in Chapter 1 and issued in terms of Chapter 3, Regulation 33(1) and (2) of the National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act, 2004 (Act 10 of 2004): Threatened or Protected Species Regulations.

FACILITIES - ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS FOR LIVING ANIMALS - FACILITY & CARE OF ANIMALS

1) The permit holder : - a) may not keep animals in cages smaller than the prescribed cage sizes without the prior written approval from the Issuing Authority. b) may not use animals for any scientific research or experimentation, without the prior written approval from the Issuing Authority. c) may not conduct / perform any other restricted activity with any animal or derivative of such specimen, unless he/she is the holder of a permit issued by the Issuing Authority, whereby the permit holder is authorized to do so. (Note: the restricted activities authorised by this permit is limited to those specified under the heading "Restricted Activities and Methods & Instruments Permitted"). d) may only keep the species and numbers of wild animals specified on this permit for the express purpose for which the permit was issued. This does not include new additions to the register. e) may only keep the animals at the locality that appears on this permit and under no circumstances may any animal be kept elsewhere than in / at the approved facilities, such as in their private homes to be treated as domestic pets. f) must ensure that all facilities / cages are cleaned at least once a day. g) must at all times ensure that all cages are kept in a clean hygienic condition, in a good state of repair, is well ventilated, provides protection against heat, cold and rain, permits sufficient light to enter and is cleaned at least once a day according to all applicable regulations. h) must at all times ensure that the animals are regularly supplied with appropriate and sufficient food, fresh drinking water, water to wash or bathe in, shade and sleeping facilities. i) remove any injured or sick animals from the holding pens to be treated at a proper holding area not open to the public. j) remove any dead animal immediately if such area is open for public display. k) must ensure that he / she has a permanent working relationship and support from a registered and practicing veterinarian. l) must ensure that a post mortem be done on animals which die at the facility where the cause of death is uncertain or unknown to assess treatment efficiency and disease control. These reports must be submitted together with the quarterly reports. **GENETIC CONTAMINATION** 2) The permit holder : - a) must keep a stud book when requested to do so. b) must take all necessary precautions to prevent genetic contamination / inbreeding of any wild animal population as a result of animals housed at the facility or released by the permit holder. c) may not import, export, sell, donate, swap, exchange, trade in any way, any wild animal or any progeny of such wild animal, unless he/she is the holder of a permit issued by the Issuing Authority, whereby the permit holder is authorized to do so. d) must ensure that where DNA testing is required, the results of such testing are available upon request.

FACILITIES - BREEDING FACILITY - CROCODILE

1) The permit holder may not provide, breed, sell, supply or export any of the species for hunting activities. 2) The permit holder must : - a) prior to conducting such activity, obtain the applicable import, export and transport permits from all applicable provinces. b) prior to conducting such activity obtain the applicable CITES permits. c) secure the services from veterinarian to care for sick or injured animals d) keep record in a register of all mortalities and report it to the Issuing Authority.

FACILITIES - STANDARD CONDITIONS

1) The permit holder may not without a permit : - trade, buy, sell, donate, receive, release, transport, import or export any animal / plant or derivative / progeny thereof. 2) The holder of the permit must on an ad hoc basis, apply for an ORDINARY Permit to carry out any additional / other restricted activity with any such specimen. 3) The permit holder must : - a) take all necessary and reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of the public and staff. b) at all times provide for the necessary public liability insurance. 4) The permit holder must : - a) keep a register on all animals received from the public b) keep such animals in a separate locality, report it to the Issuing Authority and without delay hand over such animals.

FACILITIES - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS - MANAGEMENT


1) The permit holder must : - a) have a practical and applied Management Plan for the facility. b) apply for a permit renewal in the prescribed format, when planning to continue operations at the facility, giving at least three months notice, prior to the expiry of the current permit. c) notify the Issuing Authority of any plans to close down the facility, giving at least three months notice, prior to the closing down of the facility or the expiry of the permit together with a full status report on proposed actions. (Note: Upon closure of a facility, the permit holder is responsible for all cost involved relating to the disposal of animal derivatives and/or processed products that is still at the facility at the time of closure). d) on expiry of the permit, return this permit to the Issuing Authority together with a full status report. **SPECIES RESTRICTIONS** 2) The permit holder may only : - a) keep / possess the exact species and numbers of animal / plant / derivatives and / or processed products as specified on this permit, where applicable. b) keep / possess the

animal / plant / derivatives and / or processed products at the approved locality that appears on this permit. (Note: Under no circumstances may any animal derivatives be kept elsewhere than in / at the approved facilities, such as in private homes, unless the holder thereof is in possession of the proper documentation). **ACTIVITY RESTRICTIONS** 3) The permit holder may not : - a) utilize or provide any animal / plant / derivatives and / or processed products thereof for any illegal activities. b) utilize the animal / plant / derivatives and / or processed products for the explicit purpose for which this permit was issued. c) conduct / perform any other restricted activity with any animal / plant / derivatives and / or processed products of such specimen, unless he/she is the holder of a permit issued by the Issuing Authority, whereby the permit holder is authorized to do so. (Note: the restricted activities authorised by this permit is limited to those specified under the heading "Restricted Activities and Methods Permitted"). **REGISTER, RECORDS & REPORTS** 4) The permit holder must : - a) not collect any animal / plant / derivatives and / or processed products without the written permission of the relevant landowner or received it without the written letter of donation in the prescribed format. b) keep record in the prescribed register / format of all animal / plant / derivatives and / or processed products brought to and / or received at the facility. c) retain such records for as long as the animal / plant / derivatives and / or processed products in respect of which such record has been made, is kept at the facility and at the termination of such activity, for the period of five years immediately succeeding such termination. d) ensure that no animal / plant / derivatives and / or processed products is collected without the written permission of the relevant landowner. e) ensure that animal / plant / derivatives and / or processed products is received without the written letter of donation in the prescribed format. f) produce such records at the request of an authorised person. g) supply a quarterly report to the Issuing Authority, in the same format. h) provide an annual report to the Issuing Authority within 3 months after the end of each calendar year. **SAFETY & LIABILITY** 5) The permit holder : - a) must take all necessary precautions to ensure the safety of any person working at the facility as well as those persons visiting the facility. (Note: The permit holder indemnifies the Issuing Authority / Issuing Authority. in this regard). b) is responsible for all costs regarding any incident, claim or action arising from the operation of the facility. **LEGISLATION** 6) The permit holder : - a) must at the request of authorised persons, forthwith produce all permits and make the facilities available for inspection at any reasonable time. b) is responsible to familiarise himself or herself with the detailed contents of relevant Legislation. c) who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the general or special conditions or requirements applicable to this permit, shall be guilty of an offence. 7) Any person who contravene or fail to comply with any of the conditions or requirements applicable to this permit, shall be guilty of an offence. 8) The Issuing Authority reserves the right to amend, withhold, withdraw or cancel any permit at any time, especially if the permit holder obviously neglects or fails to comply with any permit condition or requirement or is found guilty of any contravention of the applicable legislation or any other irregularity.

GENERAL CONDITIONS - ALL PERMITS

1) The Issuing Authority for this licence is : The Northwest Department of Rural, Environment and Agricultural Development (READ), Chief Directorate Environmental Services, Private Bag X 2039, Mmabatho, 2735, hereafter named "the Issuing Authority". 2) This permit, unless otherwise stated, is only valid within the boundaries of the North West Province (hereafter named "the Province") and then specifically as specified on the permit. 3) This permit is valid only : - a) for the specific species, sex and numbers as specified on this permit. b) for the specific activity / activities authorised. c) for the specified methods or instruments authorised. d) for the specific property / locality as specified. e) for the specific day, time or period stipulated. 4) This permit is only deemed valid : - a) in the original format and with the content as issued by the Issuing Authority. b) once it has been printed and the signature of the permit holder has been endorsed thereon in ink. 5) the Issuing Authority reserves the right to amend, withhold, withdraw or cancel any permit at any time. 6) This permit is not transferable to any individual, natural person, juristic person or any other legal identity. 7) Any alterations or attempt thereto, whether electronically or in any other way, shall immediately render it invalid. 8) This permit shall lapse and be deemed invalid when it is altered, lost or destroyed and no copy thereof shall be issued. 9) This permit shall also become invalid as soon as the permit holder loses possession of any animal, plant or derivative as the case may be, as specified on the permit. 10) This permit does not grant the permit holder automatic access to any Protected Area, National Park, Provincial Nature Reserve or privately owned land and : - a) the permit holder must beforehand obtain all other relevant written permissions, documents, rights and licences. b) the permit holder must comply with any other / further conditions or restrictions that the manager / landowner may stipulate at his / her discretion. 11) The permit holder must at all times while performing any restricted activity authorised by this permit, have the permit and all other relevant documentation in his / her possession and without delay make it available upon request by any authorized person. 12) An authorized person must also be allowed access onto the property at any reasonable time for any inspection needed and can remain on such property as long as it is needed to do the inspection. 13) The permit holder must immediately after completion of any activity authorised by this permit, record the required particulars in the space provided therefore or on the annexure or document attached hereto or in the prescribed register related to the permit. 14) The permit holder must return the original signed permit to the Issuing Authority within (14) fourteen days : - a) after performing or completing the authorised restricted activity, or b) after the date of expiry thereof whichever happens first, and c) if applicable furnish the Issuing Authority with a prescribed written feedback report on the results of every activity conducted. 15) The permit holder must retain a copy of the permit together with all other relevant written permissions, documents, rights and licenses for a period of at least (2) two years from date of issue or for as long as the permit holder is in possession of the animal, plant or derivative, whichever period is the longer. 16) If applicable, the permit holder shall apply for the renewal of the permit to the Issuing Authority, on the appropriate application form, at least (3) three months prior to the expiry date thereof. 17) Applications for renewal of this permit will only be processed after the original signed permit together with the prescribed written feedback report has been returned to the Issuing Authority. 18) This permit, during the period of validity thereof, is also subject to: - a) all applicable norms and standards in existence at the time of issuance. b) the provisions of any law in force, in respect of the specific species, activity, method or instrument to which this permit applies. 19) It is the permit holder's responsibility to obtain the correct information on any other legislation, specification, requirement or changes thereto that may be applicable or are required by any other Issuing Authority / Organization / Institute, relating to this permit. 20) By signing this permit, the permit holder declares that he / she is aware of the fact that : - a) any transgression or failure to return the original permit or failure to render the required reports can lead to criminal prosecution and also jeopardize any future applications by or in the name of the permit holder. b) if the permit holder contravenes or fails to comply with any permit condition or requirement, he / she shall be guilty of an offence. 21) The prescribed fees paid to the Issuing Authority for the issue of this permit shall not be refunded.


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
