HANDICAP:

If you can't record your scores or haven't received your latest index revision (Jan. 15th) be sure that you have renewed your GHIN handicap through the POA for 2020 using your same GHIN # when Every golfer will need an individual email address, no shared addresses will be allowed. If you are sharing the same email address with someone else one of you will have to establish a new email address to add to your USGA GHIN profile when renewing.

It is very important to record your score on the same day that you play your round, not the next day or next week. Course conditions will be adjusted by the USGA daily for scores recorded on the day played. Net double bogey plus course handicap strokes will be the max score that can be entered for any hole for handicapping purposes. Indexes will be adjusted on a daily basis when they require a change. Your scores can be recorded on your GHIN app, at GHIN.com or on the Club computers.
