Your Pairing Administrators are getting ready for the first play day on April 2nd. We are asking for your help this year to make things run smoothly. The sign-up deadline is 5:00 pm the Thursday before the play day. PLEASE sign-up on Total-e before the deadline. This is especially helpful on weeks where it is a team game. If you miss the sign-up deadline you must call the Pairings Coordinator listed on the WGA website Play Day Information/Tee Times tab by Monday at 5:00 pm. If you add after Monday 5:00 pm no guarantees are made that you will get a tee time as that is determined based on the play day format, player handicap, and is up to the discretion of the Pairings Administrator.

Handicaps for WGA play are calculated based on your index on the day the tee times are made. This is the Friday before we play. If you sign up late and give your current handicap you may notice a difference on the scorecard. This is due to handicaps changing daily. Tom Heffer will use the handicap as of Friday morning.
