Even with this permission, the app will only be able to read public folders on the SD card. He can't write to anything on the SD card outside his designated sandbox. The implications for the change are not yet clear, but for some devices with an SD card slot and Android 4.4 (including the popular Galaxy S4), some apps may simply not be able to do anything other than read the data stored on the SD card. While root users may end up being able to get around this, it's also unclear what will be required. The root application may request the required access, or may require changes to the ROM itself. At this point, however, if you need to reset some files on your phone, it would be best to stick to the phone's internal storage. (press) Don't let the version number fool you, Android 4.4 KitKat is not insignificant insignificant It's not a small update like Android 4.3, but a great new release with lots of important features. Google has changed the way Android looks, created its own new launcher, made dialer much smarter, further strengthened its messaging services, given the love of the Email app, and added many new features for app developers to take advantage of. Google Experience Launcher RELATED: How to install and use Google Experience Launcher on any Android Google Experience Launcher device may not technically be part of Android 4.4, but it debuted along with Android 4.4 on the Nexus 5. On Android 4.4, the Google Experience launcher has a partially transparent bar status and a navigation bar on the home screen, showing off wallpaper and hiding those black stripes. You can easily install Google Experience Launcher on any Android device running Android 4.1 or later. Google currently only officially offers Google Experience Launcher on the Nexus 5, so you'll have to activate it yourself on other devices - even other Nexus devices like the Nexus 4 and Nexus 7. Dialer Search Android 4.4 new set also allows you to search for businesses and dial their phone numbers - right from the set. For example, you can open the dial, find pizza and quickly call the nearest pizzeria. Whenever you receive a phone call, Android can now request Google's servers to provide caller identification information to you. This feature is on by default, but you can disable it if you want. Google searches are currently running on the dial. It's a built-in system feature that supports both Google Cloud Print and HP HP by default, developers can add support for new types of printers using the API. This means that Android has to work much better on low-end devices and any manufacturers still using Android 2.3 Gingerbread on their cheapest devices should finally be able to upgrade. On higher-end devices where it already performs Android should work even better. There's a new process statistics option on the hidden settings screen that displays more information about each process running and how it uses memory. This should give developers more information they can use to optimize the memory of their applications. Google's Android KitKat page lists many more features for developers.
