Some Android keyboard apps are best for one-handed use, while others are the fastest when typing with two fingers. Most on-screen keyboards need you to look at the keys, but some allow touch input. Whatever your needs, here are some keyboards for Android you should look into. Gboard is a simple standard WERTY keyboard with good predictive input and built-in speech recognition. If it's not yet installed on your device, you can download it from the game store. MessagEase is a completely different way of typing. The nine most used letters in English receive their own large key, while other letters and punctuation are available by sliding on one of these keys in one of the eight directions. It sounds tricky, but with a bit of practice using a built-in tutor, it quickly becomes instinctive. Some users report typing speeds of more than 80 words per minute, although about 30 will be typical. Although Fleksy does not support sliding, it is still one of the most popular and officially the fastest keyboard. Minumm compresses the WERTY keyboard into a thin strip along the bottom of the screen, so if screen space is your most important feature, then it could be the keyboard for you. When you need to use Minumm, it relies on predictive text to figure out what key you actually like to click, which can be hit and miss. The Nintype is a popular keyboard for the iPhone, and many regular users report input on a full-inch keyboard. Currently it is still in development for Android, but it is available for early access now. Microsoft developed its own keyboard for Windows phones called Word Flow, which was perhaps the best keyboard application for touch typing on the phone's touchscreen at 58 words per minute. Microsoft has now dropped Word Flow and bought SwftKey, although it doesn't have the one-handed touch input that Word Flow had. The most radically different approach to input on the touch screen and perhaps the most ergonomic, Dotkey is designed to work with 3 fingers from one hand and does not require on-screen buttons to be precisely selected. Instead, each finger can perform a series of gestures, such as short napkins, or long napkins. Multiple fingers can also perform these gestures at the same time. This system results in a much more ergonomic flexion and expansion of each finger, rather than the repeated abductions and additions required to enter the thumb.
