WhatsApp allows you to format text inside messages. Please note that there is no way to disable this feature. ItalicTo italicize your message, place the emphasis on both sides of the text: *text*Strikethrough To strikethrough your message, place tilde on both sides of the text: ~~text~~MonospaceTo monospace your message, place three backticks on both sides of the text: `text`Note: : Click and hold the text that you enter the text box, and then select Bold, Italic or More. Click more to choose Strikethrough or Monospace. iPhone: Click on the text that you enter into the text box, select or select all of the B_I_U. Then select Bold, Italic, Strikethrough or Monospace. On your Android phone: When you type, click and hold the part you want to format. In the menu, choose bold or Italian. Click on the more (three points) to see the options of kick and monospace. On your iPhone: When you type, click and select the word (s) that you want to format. In the menu, click on the B I U button and choose bold, Italian, percussion or monospace. Choose the text and choose the format you like. (c) Nadine Kneipinger How to emphasize text in WhatsApp, there are no commands or options on the menu that could be used to emphasize text. The only way to do this is by downloading the BlueWords app - Text Styles. However, it works for Android smartphones. You may not know, but WhatsApp released an update last year that allows users to send send bold, italics and strikethrough. Here's how to do it: Step 1. Start WhatsApp messenger on your iPhone or Android. Step 2. Start typing the message. Step 3. If you want your text to look bold, just before and after the text before and after the text before and after adding asterisk (also known as the star). When you click to send, WhatsApp will automatically make the text appear in bold. Step 4. If you prefer to send your message in the language of lyteria, you can do so by adding a highlight I before and after the text, both with sending a message in bold. Step 5. To send a message to strikethrough, you need to add tilde or me before and after the text. These steps work for smartphones that work on both Android and iOS systems. However, iPhones don't display formatted text as you type, so don't worry if your messages are in bold, italics or strikethrough. Once you click the send, WhatsApp will display the correct format. In case you're wondering, you can also send a message that's bold, greasy and percussive by posting asterisk, emphasize and tilde before and after the message. Markup characters can help you emphasize certain words or phrases by making them multi-galleryized or bold, and this will even allow you to cross out words and change the font. This is one of those nice touches that are not available in most other messaging apps. The feature is available for both iOS and Android devices, and there are minor differences between them. In older versions of WhatsApp, Android phones had more options that the iPhone would have, but now it's pretty much the same across the board. So make sure you've updated the latest version of WhatsApp for Android or iOS to get the most out of text formatting in chat rooms. Don't miss: Forward WhatsApp Messages and apps to other contacts for Android and iOS devices, WhatsApp allows you to format messages with all-around, bold, and percussion text just by typing special characters before and after text in a message. Using these special symbols is called marking. You can even turn a regular font into a monospace font with the right syntax. Here's how you do it: Introduce a stress (!) on either side of a word or phrase to it It. Example: word will end up as a word. Example: Example: would add strikethrough to it. Enter three serious accents, aka backquotes or backticks ('), on either side of a word or phrase to use a monospace font. The example of the word will be displayed in a new font. WhatsApp for both mobile operating systems displays live viewing of text attributes when text is changed, so you can see exactly how messages will appear in their formatted state when sent. And you can combine errant, bold, and strikethroughs if you want, but if you apply monospace to any other formatted text, it will undo it because monospace removes all formatting when the font changes. In addition to the markup formatting option, both Android and iOS app contains a simple contextual menu where you can choose bold, italic, strikethrough, or monospace. On Android, long tap your target word then drag the beginning and ending of the selectors to highlight more words or characters if necessary. On iOS, you can do this too, but you can also double-click the word rather than see the choice. Next, on Android, tap the vertical ellipse from the contextual menu that pops up, and then choose your formatting option. On iOS, tap the BIU item from the context menu and then select the formatting option. The markup symbols will be automatically applied to the chosen attribute. As you can see, text message formatting is easy on WhatsApp, whether you choose a markup or contextual menu. And you can still use

highlights, asterisks, tilds, and serious accents on their own. If there is only one character for each, it will show how this character is. There is no way to turn WhatsApp text formatting with these character markups. If you need to show two identical characters in a message but don't want to change the format, there aren't many options. For bold, weird and percussion, you can use one or all of them to format the entire message and then add a character in between where you need them as needed. It's not the best workaround, but that's where the monospace text comes in. This allows you to improve text message with bold, italics, monospace, and kick. This is especially useful when you're hired for a long message. You can highlight by making a few bold words or make headlines with it. Similarly, italics and strikethrough will help you liven up and spice up the conversation. So, open the app, and let me show you how to compose WhatsApp messages with these text styles. How to write Bold in WhatsApp to enter in bold, insert an asterisk (star) at the beginning and end of a word, sentence, or paragraph. For example, if you type iGeeksBlog as iGeeksBlog on WhatsApp, it will automatically be bold. If you give one string of space, you will have to insert the star at the end and start again. How to write an Italian language in WhatsApp For introduction to italic, insert an underlinage at the beginning and end of a word, sentence or paragraph. For example, to write iGeeksBlog into a page language on WhatsApp, type it as iGeeksBlog Repeat the process if you enter the line space between words or sentences. How to write Strikethrough in WhatsApp to hit a word, sentence or paragraph, insert tilde (approximate sign) at the beginning and end. For example, to hit the word iGeeksBlog on WhatsApp, brand it as iGeeksBlog It will appear as iGeeksBlog How to write a monospace in WhatsApp To format your message with monospace, place three backticks at the beginning and end. For example, iGeeksBlog Note: To type backticks on the iPhone, press one quote key for a long time. (') Can I disable WhatsApp formatting styles? No, you can't turn it off. As a result, one interesting thing to note is if you insw billion 5 star characters (asterisk) together (yap.) and hit the send button, it will automatically become 3 stars (me). The WhatsApp app automatically inserts signs and formats text. This option, however, is not available on the computer. On WhatsApp for Mac, I tried to select typed words and hit commands and B. But the text was not formatted. That's all! Signing off ...
