I've been thinking since I made my gifts this year I wanted to make the boxes they came from as well. The crate can be done regardless of the size you need, and I made mine about 1 1/2 more than the gift I used scrap 2x4 and cut it down to 3/8 strips with my group seen, but any wooden work. I also used 8 loops 12 of 1/4 dowel and 1/2 dowel. I had a few 1/2 finishing nails, so I used them to nail the sides together. I had a 2x4 piece with a large knot hole that would be a scrap, so I thought it would be perfect for a gift box. I started with 12 long pieces and cut them, so I ended up with so many 3/8x3 1/2x12, how do I need to make a box I cut some small strips about 3/8x1x7 depending on how big your sides are and nailed it together, how, well, the crate sides. I then added loops from the inside to the bottom to make the sides fall out. I drilled a piece of 1 dowel, cut it into 2 small pieces, and cut the slot into one to tie them together and glued it back together. I then used 2 out of 1/4 dowel to glue it to the lid. The hinge for the lid is 4 cubes about 3/4 square. The two outer cubes have 1/4 holes to store the dowel and the inner cubes have 3/8 holes. All the cubes were cut on my lane seen to cut the curves so the lid would open, then just glued to the back and lid. I drilled 6 holes in the lid and put 1/2 long pieces of 1/4 dowel through them to keep the sides. Close the window up and when someone pulls the ring the top lifts and all the sides fall away showing the gift in How do you organize and carry several items and then use the same carrier to show those items? Paper bags can work, but can be quite weak and certainly not worthy of a show. Cardboard boxes work well enough until they get wet or you overload them and again, not much for the eyes. Milk boxes are great if you happen to have lots of them to use, but they are relatively small and not the most attractive thing. You can also go to your local craft shop and order some nice wooden boxes with 3/8 thick slats and 3/4 wooden sides with handles. They work well overall and look good, but over time thin slats will break, come separate, or lose. So what do we do? It's simple enough to build the final wooden box! These animals are used by my wife to carry all her goods to the markets she visits. Basically she uses them for her bread, which are loaded into her bakery and then stacked in a truck. The depth of the drawers was specially designed to fit the bread in them vertically, so there would not be enough space top of the drawer and at the end of a loaf of bread to fold another box right on top. The drawers are designed so that when empty, they can be stacked with a third drawer sandwiched between them to help preserve space. They are made entirely of 3/4 of the eastern white pine bought at the local mill (to make five of them cost as little as \$50). They're just just and nailed together and really indestructible. The drawers are also used to transport pottery and woodworking to markets and were easily loaded with fifty pounds of material without problems (I'm sure you could double that no problem... but then again, what do you bring to the market, which is what's heavy?). They are easy to build and a great project for an ingestion woodworker... That's why I would like to post it here to instructables. I had my younger brother helping me in the store because he expressed some interest in using woodworking machines, and this project includes the use of a router, chainsaw, miter saw, saw table, air compressor, nail gun, orbital dander, and measuring tools such as squares, tape measures, and rulers. The perfect project for a novice woodworker! Parts: standard light kit, French Cleat kit, and square box (available at Home Depot). Tools: You'll need Brad Nail, the screw driver, and saw. We recommend Ryobi's wireless one-nail gun, drill, and meiter seen. Equipment: 2 1/2 nails, 1 1/2 wooden screws Presents hard.
