Domestic and child violence rates in Peru are high and alarming; for this reason, Aldeas Infantiles SOS Peru has decided to launch a campaign for a family free of violence that has no purpose but to raise awareness among parents, authorities and civil society of the need for healthy coexistence free from all forms of abuse. Families free from violence will seek to promote preventive action against domestic violence. For this reason, they have made it possible to establish this link where information is provided, recommendations to create a positive family environment, with a particular emphasis on respect for the rights of children and adolescents. SOS Peru National Director of Children's Villages Nancy Martinez noted that domestic violence rates have increased dramatically around the world in 2020, mainly due to the emergence of the coronavirus pandemic and the isolation measures taken by various governments, making it easier for aggressors to access victims. In the Peruvian case, 100 consultations increased by 97 per cent between January and August compared to cases reported in 2019, exceeding 156,000,300 calls (an average of 640 per cent per day); July 2020, the month with the highest peak is reflected in a 190 percent increase. Girls, boys and adolescents are most affected by the escalation of domestic violence during the state of emergency. (Photo: Andean) In this sense, Martinez narrowed down: It is also time to demonstrate the growing curve of the pandemic of violence and to strive for a society to be free of this virus, mainly girls, boys and adolescents. But what direct action will SOS Peru Children's Villages' campaign take for Families Free of Violence? The most specific of them are framed in the context of the state of emergency with trainings, national seminars on active education of children, positive education of children, as well as collections. In the latter, from 9 to 30 October, SOS Children's Villages of Peru will seek to raise the number of 300,000 suns, which will be aimed at feeding more than 4,000,500 children, adolescents and vulnerable families, supported by the organization's family strengthening programs. And not only that, because it will open a volunteer program whose registration will be open from 5 to 13 this month, which will be trained in a virtual way and with a certificate issued in the name of SoS Children's Villages Peru. The consequences of COVID-19 have made inequality in the world, including gender inequality, is most evident. For many women and girls, domestic violence is a threat exacerbated in our time of isolation. That is why, from UNDP in partnership with local authorities in Lima, we are responding to this gender-coded pandemic to care for and protect potential victims. Sixty percent of women in Peru come home, according to the Crime Prosecutors' Observatory. In emergencies such as UN Women and UNDP, the risk of violence against women and girls increases in this private space. The Peruvian State is leading important efforts to curb this domestic violence during the health crisis. Within 23 days of the emergency, he responded to more than 8,000 calls across the 100 line, about 360 calls every day. It also transferred 36 people to temporary shelters and cared for 43 women victims of sexual violence, 27 of whom, more than half of them, were girls. However, the actions of local authorities are also necessary and certainly necessary. Through the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), in partnership with the municipalities of Lima, San Juan de Miraflores and Villa Salvador, we are implementing an initiative to reach the homes of families in these three areas in times of crisis, through messages and awareness-raising measures to prevent violence and promote equality. It is not easy in this context of isolation to come up with information on issues related to home privacy. However, we find different ways. One is the food baskets that municipalities supply from the budget transferred by the central Government. These baskets carry reports of gender-based violence, shared responsibilities, masculinity and healthy motherhood, which will also be channelled through existing community networks in each district. Another way is to participate in the response to the pandemic: solid waste collectors and collectors and the Peruvian national police. Although both actors are often not visible, they play an important role in the dynamics of our cities and keep in touch with quarantine families. Therefore, they are of strategic importance for the arrival with messages to these homes, allowing this model to be replicated by other local authorities during quarantine. Both collectors and collectors and the Peruvian National Police will be strengthened, as well as information on domestic violence care services. So collectors will be converted into vehicles to communicate with citizens. At the same time, police stations in each sector will operate on the protocol of home visits in accordance with geo-advisory monitoring of protective measures. In this regard, the Mayor of San Juan de Miraflores, Cristina Nina, stressed the importance of this alliance with UNDP and its implementation in its jurisdiction, where the level of domestic and women's violence is a cause for concern, especially at this difficult time we are going through. This comprehensive intervention is joined by UNDP support from the lima metropolitan municipality of Lima for a shelter for women, meuukahs as a result of violence, through technical assistance and communication with private enterprises. Community participation and engagement is key to an effective and comprehensive response to gender-based violence and inequality, especially in our time. Today we started with families in the areas of Lima, San Juan de Miraflores and Villa Salvador. In the near future, we hope to add more local authorities to ensure equality.
