According to the July 2012 Labour Force Survey (LFS), the unemployment rate in the country is 7% (National Statistical Office, 013). Unemployment in the Philippines in 2012 is one of the worst in Asia, higher than its Southeast Asian neighbors, according to the country's Bureau of Labor and Employment Statistics (BLES) (Nepomuceno-Rodriguez, 2012). The World Bank has identified the Philippines as one of the most dangerous countries in the world; The Philippines is also located along the Pacific Ring of Fire, an area prone to typhoons, floods, earthquakes and volcanic activity (World Bank, 2013). The effects of these disasters have a significant impact on the country's workforce. For example, the devastation caused by massive floods due to super typhoons will affect areas that rely on farmland. THE Philippines is on the rise, but the current growth trajectory is not substantially job creation.
