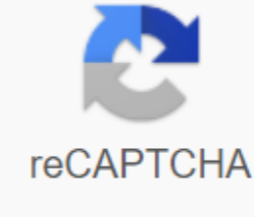

As we've installed over and over again, your clever tricks don't protect your password. If you or someone you know uses Bible links as a password, that trick is pretty easy to crack, too. For example, using a password on Bible verses, such as john316 or psalm23, is a popular way to create a memorable password. An analysis of the 2009 Rockyou hack that revealed 32 million usernames and passwords found that various Bible verses accounted for a large number of passwords. As the news site Boing Boing notes, they are easy to remember, but they are also quite easy to crack. Even if you don't use the popular verse as a password, using the Bible as a template still gives hackers a way to guess what you're doing: An article in Christianity Today advises against using your life verse as a password, but doesn't warn that other ways of turning verses into passwords - like using the first letter of each word in verse - are also pretty weak, in that it's easy for computers to compile a database of all the easy-to-remember passwords that can be built this way. If you study the Bible regularly, using verses or basing your password on a passage is tempting because you already memorize the text. However, remember that hackers can always figure out the patterns you use and they have a lot more collective time to devote to it.
