Connect your phone to your computer with a USB charger. Open Command Prompt on your computer by clicking on the Windows-R button and then typing cmd. In the team window quickly, enter: adb shell pm grant com.cannic.apps.automaticdarktheme android.permission.WRITE_SECURE_SETTINGS Press Enter to launch the team. Once you've made changes, you can close Command Prompt and disconnect your phone from your computer. You should also be able to disable USB debugging (for extra security). Click the Turn on the Dark Theme button or turn the light theme on to adjust the time each theme will apply. You can also change whether the app is applying the change at a specified time, or only while the screen is locked. Switching while locking your phone screen is the preferred option. Otherwise, any open apps or menus must be overloaded when the theme changes, which can lead to visual errors or performance issues. Dark Sky is no more, at least for Android users. Following the acquisition of Apple's Dark Sky, the popular weather app is being pulled from the Google Play Store and will stop for Android smartphones and devices to wear OS from July 1. Well, it presents its forecasts in a more plainspoken and casual language than other apps, while its use of the timeline to present updated weather info makes its data packaging more digestible. However, if you prefer more traditional weather bulletins, Appy Weather allows you to check hourly and daily forecasts, as well as 48-hour and weekly outlines.
