You must be enrolled in a state-approved driver training program and an affidavit completing the Driver Education Class Course. Yes. If you are applying for a license in Centennial State for the first time, you will need to have: Documents confirming your identity. Documents confirming that you are a Resident of Colorado Affidavit Responsibility and Custody (if under 18) Affidavit completing a driver education class course (if between 15 and 15 1/2) Completing a 4-hour driver training program (if between 15 1/2 and 16 years old) there are three types of permits, Available in Colorado. Driver Education Permission for ages 15 - 15 1/2 Driver Awareness Resolution at age 15 1/2 - 16. Minor Instruction Permit for ages 16 1/2 - 21. This will be best determined by your age. If you are under the age of 18, your parent will have to sign an affidavit on liability and guardianship. This is usually done in front of an official in the car's office. Contact the Colorado Automobile Office directly for other options if your legal guardian cannot bring you. An employee of the car office will briefly check whether you have any physical ailments or disabilities that may affect your driving. Yes. You'll have to submit a vision test. You will have your photo taken in the car office when you take the exam. This is what you need to do in order to get a license in Colorado. If you fail the permit test, you will be able to use it again the next day. Don't worry..... if you don't test your permission, you can take it again the next day. There may be certain limitations. You may have to wait a little longer if you get more than half of them wrong. If you are under 16, you can only travel with the person who has signed your application for responsibility and guardianship. If you are over 16 years old, you can drive with a Colorado licensed driver 21 or older. You can only drive with a certified driving instructor or a person who has signed an affidavit of responsibility and Guardianship. You are always encouraged to drive on different road situations in order to get a good experience. Just remember to always drive with a certified instructor to the person who has signed your account and guardianship affidavit. During your 12-month wait, you are responsible for getting at least 50 hours behind the wheel training. Here are the options for this training: You can either: Get 20 hours of training at state-approved driving schools, as well as 30 hours of parenting under supervision driving Get 50 hours of training by parents or a legitimate guardian Get 6 hours of training from a state-approved driver training course, as well as an additional 44 hours of parenting under the supervision of driving. You should always make sure that you are traveling with the person who signed your affidavit. In some cases, the person may appoint another controlling licensed driver aged 21 and over to accompany you. You will need to accept: Your permit is a \$21 license fee A of registered and insured vehicles Drive Time Log Leaf Colorado Road Test is based on the American Association of Vehicle Administrators and will be divided into 3 categories: PERCEPTUAL: You will judge your ability to interpret traffic, PERICUAL - MOTOR: You will judge your ability to drive and respond to driving stimuli. ATTENTION SHARING: You will judge your ability to do more than one performance at the same time, such as steering wheel, speed control and watch traffic. The night before the road test can be used as the last practice run before a road test. Don't cross the stop line or cross the stop signs. Don't suddenly speed up. New drivers under the age of 18 cannot travel with a passenger under the age of 21 for the first 6 months after obtaining a license. During the first year with a license, you can't drive between midnight and 5 a.m. there are a few things to keep in mind when driving in Colorado for the first time: Be on the lookout for deer strikes Watch over the mountains and curve roads. Remember that speed speed for dry conditions, so be careful when the weather is unfavorable. Colorado drivers should be held accountable and no - insurance is the fault. You should have proof insurance with you at all times. The minimum amount of coverage is \$25,000 per victim, \$50,000 for an accident, and \$15,000 for damage to property. Most insurance companies want basic information from you. They want information about the vehicle, such as the year to make, model and mileage. They also want your name, address and driving record. A recent study found that 78% of car drivers in Colorado overpay for coverage. The legal limit is 0.08% if you are over 21 and 0.02% if you are under the age of 21. If you are legally stopped, all drivers in Colorado consent to testing your blood or breathing alcohol.
