There will be a total of 100 questions, each of which bears one sign. The maximum weight is given by numerical ability and reasoning ability (35 marks each). IBPS Clerk Syllabus (Basic) will have four sections- General/Financial Awareness, General English, Quantitative Ability, Reasoning Ability, and Computer Ability. There will be a total of 200 questions, the maximum weight given in the Reasoning section and the computer with 60 marks. The IBPS Clerk 2020 preliminary exam will be held on 12, 13 and 19 December 2020. IBPS Clerk Admitting cards for the same will be issued in the last week of November 2020.
