


Setup office 365 email account on android

Organizations using Office 365 will soon be able to control iOS, Android and Windows Phone smartphones and tablets without paying anything extra. The new features allow administrators to delete corporate information and leave personal information; Ensure that email and documents are synchronized only on corporate phones and tablets and prevent access from prison devices with office 365. With the announcement, Microsoft hopes to show that it is serious about mobile device and application management because to date it just hasn't done enough, according to Leif-Olof Wallin, vice president of research at Gartner. The launch shows Microsoft has ambitions to become a more complete management provider. This shows Microsoft is serious about wanting to handle both PCs and smartphones. I think it's a really good idea and I see this as one step in Microsoft's push to take a bigger share of the smartphone market. Wallin said. The Office 365 management update will be available during the first quarter of next year, and was announced Tuesday at the TechED Europe conference in Barcelona. Opportunities will be included in all Office 365 commercial subscriptions, including business, businesses, EDU and government plans. A big trend in the management space are the tools that can control smartphones, tablets and PCs. Until now, mobile devices have been controlled with separate tools, but in the long run it is too expensive. That's where we go and what everyone wants. One policy is deployed at all endpoints, regardless of screen size, Wallin said. The mobile device management features built into Office 365 are equipped with the Microsoft Intune platform, which will offer more advanced features for companies willing to pay extra. These include mobile application management features and the ability to automatically deploy certificates, Wi-Fi, VPNs, and email profiles after the device is registered, for example. Intune is also getting an update over the next few months, according to Microsoft. Adding mobile device management features is just part of Microsoft's plan to make online offerings more secure. The company also adds features to detect and protect sensitive content in Office documents in Exchange Online, SharePoint Online and OneDrive for business, the company said in a blog post. At TechED, Microsoft has also opened Office 365 to third-party developers through APIs that allow other companies to add features and features to the online performance service. The company said it wants to move monitoring and analytics to the cloud, automate management and take on high-elite computing with their latest Azure products as well. Many moons ago, Google included both the Gmail app and the stock email app (for non-Gmail accounts) in Android. Android. Many third-party manufacturers still include standalone email apps. Gmail now works with any kind of third-party email accounts that supports IMAP, so you can handle all your emails in one place. It's almost like having a cake and eating it too. To add a Gmail-free account to the Gmail app, first tap the burger menu or swipe on the left side of the screen in Gmail by opening the menu. From here, tap your name/email address, which will open a drop down to change, add and manage accounts. Click Add your account. The next screen will give you a list of options: Google, Outlook, Hotmail, Live, Yahoo, Exchange and others. Just choose the one that best relates to what you're trying to add. I use Live Email address in this example, but the process should be basically the same across the board (unless you set up a corporate email address with specific settings, of course). In our test scenario, this opens a Microsoft login window, but the idea will be the same in all accounts: log in. The next screen will likely require Gmail to share your account and then ask you to confirm the frequency of synchronization. In our example, push services are not available, so they simply sync your email to a regular schedule. From there, just confirm your name and that's it, you're ready to roll! If you have multiple email accounts in multiple services, the ability to manage them all in one app is great. And when it's a Gmail app, it's even better- Google's approach to email is arguably the best, so being able to incorporate some of its nicer features into other services is always welcome. Very few, if any, iOS email apps allow you to add POP email accounts. Some Android email apps do, but not much out there, either. If you're wondering why you want to add a POP email account on your mobile device, you can read about the difference between IMAP and POP and the benefits of each one. We've previously shown you how to add an email address to the Mail app on iOS devices. But the Mail app only handles IMAP email. If you decide to add a POP email account to your iOS or Android device so you can have email locally on your device, we'll show you how to use Outlook.com to do so. Add an email account Outlook.com you'll need a Microsoft email account, such as a outlook.com, live.com, or hotmail.com. If you don't have one, sign up for a Microsoft account. Go to Outlook.com and log in with a Microsoft account. If you have an Office 365 subscription, it's best to use a subscription-related email address. This way you get a premium version of the Outlook.com which does not contain ads and offers advanced security features. To make an POP email account available in Outlook for iOS or Android, you must add it as a connected account to Outlook.com. Outlook will then see the connected account and allow you to add it. In Outlook.com, click the Settings icon (transmission) in the top right corner of the window. Then click View all Outlook settings. On the Settings screen, click Mail on the left, sync email in the middle, and then other email accounts under connected accounts on the right. You can add a Gmail account, but for example, we'll add a personal email address to your custom domain. Gmail is best you can't add to your IMAP account to Outlook without Outlook.com. On the Connect your account page, enter the display name. This is the name recipients will see when they receive an email from you. Then enter the email address and password for the email account you want to connect to Outlook.com account. If you've included two-factor authentication (which is a good idea) for a connected email account, mail, you need to create an app password for that account for use in Outlook.com. On another tab in your browser, go to the email provider's account security page and create an app password for Outlook.com. Then go back to the Outlook.com tab and enter the application password in the password field in the Connect your account. If you want to keep your email for your connected account separate from your Microsoft account, select Create a new folder for imported email with subfolders, such as the account you connect. Another option would be to combine all emails from both accounts. If you're adding an email address that's not from a general or known email provider, you may have to manually enter the POP settings. Check the manual settings box for your account. Click OK. When choosing the type of connection, select the POP/SMTP connection settings. Enter incoming and outgoing information about the server and port. You can get this information from your provider if you don't have it yet. If you don't want people to see your Outlook.com address (or other Microsoft email address) when you send an email via a connected account to Outlook.com, select Send email from your provider's server. Click OK. On the Sync email screen, click Save if you've made any other changes to your settings. Then click Close (X), if you choose to store your email for a connected account in a separate folder, you'll see an email address listed under Folders and a mailbox under your email address. Click on your inbox to see messages for your connected account. If your connected email address doesn't appear under Folders on the left, click on the photo or initials in the top right and click out. Then go back in. Add your POP email address to Outlook for iOS If you don't have any email addresses in the Outlook app for iOS, you'll see the found accounts screen when you think about Outlook. All accounts are selected by default. Disable all other accounts except the POP account to Outlook.com. Click Add account. Then enter the password on the next screen and click Login. You'll see a connected POP email account in the list of folders in the inbox menu under your email address. Click on the inbox to see the emails for this account. If you already have one or more email addresses in Outlook for iOS, you won't see the found accounts screen. But you can add a connected POP email account to your settings. The menu button in the top left top left option to reopen the menu if it is not open. Then click the Settings (transmission) icon in the bottom left, as shown in the picture on the right above. On the settings screen, under the accounts, click Add account. Then click Add your email account. You'll see the same screen shown on the left above, and you can continue to add a connected POP email account from there. Add your POP email address to Outlook for Previously, we've looked at how to add email addresses to Outlook for Android. In Outlook, you should see the following screen showing which email accounts have been found, like in Outlook for iOS. Choose a connected POP email account that you've added Outlook.com and click Add account. You'll be asked if you want to add another account, but you can tap Skip for the time being. Your POP email account is now available in Outlook for Android. It may take some time for messages to be downloaded, depending on how many of them are in your account. More email options for iOS and Android This solution in Outlook is a roundabout way to add a POP email account to iOS and Android, but it's a decent option. If you prefer to use other email apps, we have several options for Android. And there's always a standard Mail app for iOS. But, most email apps for iOS and Android only allow IMAP email accounts.
