Each poster presentation stands out one poster board. Posters (the size of ISO A0) will be displayed throughout the conference. The author must be present at the specified time during the scheduled poster viewing sessions. Presenters should use mounting tape to put up their posters. The installation will be prepared by the Secretariat. The location of the poster will be announced at a later date. The size of the ISO A0 poster with a portrait orientation (W 841 mm x H 1189 mm). The name should consist of capital letters at least one inch high. Use the minimum amount of text possible. Use only what is needed to make your point of view. - Be concise, but answer the basic questions (What, when, where, why) using the standard format. - Introduction: background, problem statement, goal/goal. - Methods: experimental design, technique. - Results: summary of data, conclusions. Conclusions: interpretations, consequences; organize material to tell a logical, coherent story. Use large, BOLD labels for readability. Use fonts that are easy to read (i.e. avoid fancy fonts). The entire text should be easily read from a 2-meter (l) distance. Use boundaries or white space for individual sections. Avoid large, continuous blocks of text. Use numbers (graphs, diagrams, and illustrations) (with captions) as much as possible, making sure they are legible. Using color will increase the readability of the posters (i.e. contrast and highlight important points) and attractiveness. Aesthetics is an important part of poster preparation that will attract attention. To summarize the results/conclusions. Bullets work well to summarize key points or contribution research. Keep your poster simple and provide a clear message to take home; You can provide detailed information during discussions or during a conference call. All presentations must be in English. PowerPoint Presentation .ppt (x) objects will be provided. All speakers must move their presentation to the conference laptop before the session begins. A personal laptop will only allow electronic slide presentations in Microsoft PowerPoint .ppt/.pptx or Portable Document File (PDF) formats. Please make sure that all graphics are built into the Microsoft PowerPoint presentation file .ppt/.pptx. When you create slides, check your settings to make sure your page is set up for The On-Screen Show (4:3). Fonts should be standard (recommended to use sans serif fonts) such as Arial or Courier. Introduce yourself to the session chair before the session. All abstracts must be presented and presented in clear English with precise grammar and quality writing suitable for publication. You will receive confirmation that your abstract has been received, with an abstract name that you have submitted. Status notifications will be sent after the verification process has been completed. Note: Abstract should be a brief summary of your presentation How to avoid the use of scientific or engineering symbols, abbreviations and bullets It should be punished in one space in 9 points like Century Gothic Be necessarily stick to the word limitation (250 words) Representation of abstracts is the consent of the authors to publish. Notifications of publication in the AIP process will be sent to the authors by email. The authors of the adopted abstracts will be able to publish in scopus-indexed AIP, based on the charge processing article (APC) of \$70. The APC will be cancelled for the first 20 accepted abstracts for the ARCSB 2017 conference. Authors of accepted abstracts wishing to publish in the AIP process are required to prepare an extended abstract in accordance with the guiding principle of the AIP proceedings. In addition, individual abstracts will also be able to publish their articles in indexed ISI-Scopus Sains Malaysiana, with an additional fee. Notice of publication in Sains Malaysiana will be sent to the authors by email. The authors of the selected abstracts are required to prepare the full manuscript in accordance with the guiding principle of Sains Malaysiana. All manuscripts are subject to peer review and must meet the standards of academic excellence. Strict time-keeping will ensure the smooth running of the entire program. SUBMISSION PROCEDURE The Journal publishes manuscripts written in Malay and English. The manuscript submitted to the magazine for publication must be an original contribution and should not have been published earlier or at the same time by any other publication. The manuscript must be written at a double interval, one column, and font size 12 on A4 paper, no more than 25 pages, no more than 6 digits and 6 tables, and must be presented using an online submission system. From January 1, 2013, all applications must be made through this online system. FORMAT AND STYLE The title of the manuscript should be concise, descriptive and preferably no more than 15 words. The manuscript should contain annotations describing its main points within 150 to 250 words in Malay and English. For authors who are unable to provide a Malay version of the abstract, the editor will provide assistance. In general, the content should include introduction, materials and methods, results and discussions, conclusion, recognition and references. The manuscript should be equipped with 3-5 key words. All illustrations, including numbers, diagrams, and graphs, should be marked and provided on pages separate from the text. Desired text should be clearly stated. These illustrations should be called and the measurements serial as numbers. All illustrations must be clearly drawn in permanent ink or photographed in sharp black and white and reproduced in the form of high-contrast glossy prints or digital images and provided in the finished form of the camera. References in the text should be denoted by giving the author's (s) name. All alphabetically ordered lists of links should be included at the end of the manuscript. All links in the text should appear on the help list. The authors are responsible for the accuracy and completeness of all the information in the reference. The manuscripts must correspond to Penerbit UKM or Chicago Style Guide (University of Chicago Press). The accepted style of reference should be consistent throughout the manuscript. Click here for the manuscript template. COPYRIGHT It is the author's responsibility to make sure that his or her submitted work does not infringe any existing copyright. Authors must obtain permission to reproduce or adapt copyrighted material and provide proof of approval when submitting the final version of the manuscript. The REVIEWS PROCESS manuscripts will be reviewed by the editors and at least one independent referee. Decisions relating to the publication of the manuscript will be based on the Council's recommendations. The manuscript will be judged on the basis of its appropriateness for Sains Malaysiana, contribution to discipline, resting analysis, conceptual breadth, clarity of presentation and technical adequacy. Manuscripts submitted by members of the magazine's editorial board are subject to the same procedure.
