Smart is an understatement when it comes to Cosatto To and Fro. If you thought it was just another bright umbrella once stroller, then think again! It is clear that To and Fro strives to establish itself as a travel system, not just an average stroller. It offers all the great tourist systems can, but in umbrella times. In fact, Cosatto are so confident in the ability of their To and Fro tourist system to last your child's infant life that they have included a free four-year warranty with a stroller. Inside the box are endless surprises. Obviously a generous brand, including many extra accessories for free. To and Fro is an extremely sturdy stroller, weighing in at 12.6kg and measuring 49cm wide. Of course, it has a signature Cosatto splash of color added to the frame. The wheels are made of hard-wearing rubber with front wheels having the ability to be locked. As the stroller boasts all the round suspension, it gives a comfier ride for the baby through the urban areas. Convenient to push and easily maneuvers through small aisles and at corners when out of the shops. The handles on To and Fro are conveniently lined with tight foam to wear and adjust to two different height positions, pressing a handy, if slightly sharp, quick release button. To stop To and Fro in their tracks, the brake is simple to put on, but sometimes uncomfortable to release like pedals While it won't fit a bunch of purchases, the basket has plenty of potential to carry every day bits and beans you need to carry around. It is an adequate size for a stroller with an umbrella and is available from the back and sides of the stroller. When the seat is completely reclined in newborn mode, access is a bit limited, but Cosatto tried to make it easier by adding lightning on the side of the basket. Now this is where the magic happens! The 'duo directional' seat flips with a forward face to the parent in front of the mode and has a built-in harness on either side of the seat, so there is no need to tinker around adjusting the harness every time you change the direction of the seat. Instructions on how to change the direction of the seat are easy to use. However, it's not easy enough to do with one hand - you definitely need two baby free hands to do it as there are plenty of Velcro to sort out. The seat boasts several different rear seat positions, from lying flat to sitting straight, which is easily adjustable using the lever on the back of the seat. The seat comes from the new bornin forward face and parents in front of the modes as it lies flat in both directions. The seat has adjustable call support in forward fast-forward mode, which doubles as a smart back support in parental mode. The seat is also beautifully padded, and of course colorful, giving your little man a lot of look while they stroll around. The 5-point adjustable strap is comfy soft with even more color-coordinated covers adding to the quality of the stroller feel. Adjusting the seat belts to three slots in the seat is quite possible, however a little uncomfortable, so you may need to keep yourself a few minutes to make sure your stroller is sorted and fits your child well. Hood To and Fro has a UPF 50 protection rating and gives great coverage. It has to pull down the visor to give extra protection against these extra strong rays. The hood was relatively quiet in its movement, though not as sturdy as I expected from such a deftly thought-out stroller. At the back of the hood there is a handy storage bag to keep all kinds of nick-nacks in as well as a magnetic, silent peek hole to check on your little one easier. The hood reversibly boasts a different fabric design on both sides and just flips when changing the stroller with a forward face to the parent facing - very simple but very smart! The great thing about To and Fro is that it folds into compact umbrella style times no matter which direction the seat faces. The fold is similar to the other umbrella folding stroller and is done by pulling the release ring up and pushing down the lock's feet on the side of the frame. It's quick to do and has an automatic lock to help it in a compact package. Best of all About To and Fro times there should be a booth, which means that the stroller is self-contained when the folder is a great feature that makes storing strollers much easier. To unwrap the stroller you flick the auto-lock hook from the frame and press down on the foot pedal and press the stroller into place. To and Fro changes the direction of the seat, but is also compatible with the Cosatto Hold car seat, which can be purchased separately. Car seat adapters go free in a box with a stroller and are easily trimmed on the side frame of the stroller. There are several other accessories included that coordinate with fun fabric stroller prints. First, there is a handy head-to-head should give extra support to your new born. There is also a reversible footmuff that can double as a stroller liner when the front zips off. The footmuff liner contains a removable wedge to support the backs of younger children. The front of the footmuff also boasts a mini-hand warmer to keep your kids very cozy and snug in cold weather - another example of Cosatto's clever attention to detail with this stroller. The cup holder is included, although Cosatto is to prepare that it will only be used in advanced cladding mode for safety reasons.
