You will need a raster-based graphics program and a little patience to get it right. If you delete words or cut out whole lines, you can do a small operation to cut and paste, but in most cases, you need to reprint completely. So get those fingers warmed up and get ready for the type! Open your bitmap text in Adobe Photoshop. If you're cutting out words or strings, select the text you want to delete with a rectangular marquee tool. Fill this area with white. If you have a space that needs to be closed, select the text with a marquee tool, cut it out and insert it into an empty space. Trim the image as needed. If you need to edit the text, the best thing to do is to reprint it. Add this to the text layer and adjust the size and font until it fits perfectly on top of the old text. Copy and paste text into Adobe Illustrator, MS Word or other program that will allow you to edit it the next time you open it.
