Do you find yourself piling on the foundation sometimes while trying to cover a sudden bout of acne? Do you think that no matter how fully coverage of your concealer, your bags under your eyes still seem to come through? You may need some color change makeup items in your arsenal to give you that coverage without makeup looking ever seeming heavy or cakes. In this article, I go on the theory behind color makeup correction, I explain what colors work to hide what are the drawbacks, I give you the best method for applying color makeup and I finish with a list of the best color correctors on the market. Enjoy! Color Correction Guide: Content What is a color makeup color correction? Color correctors most often take the form of a concealer, although color corrects primer, foundations and powders also exist. Instead of skin tone as your average concealer, they tend to be a pale shade of green, yellow, lavender or peach. When applied over some kind of discoloration on the skin, these color correctors neutralize discoloration and eliminate the need for a heavy foundation. The best green correctors are 1. Doctors Formula Conceal Rx Doctors Sila Concealer's Green Big Color Corrector may be polarizing. This ultra-softened green concealer is ideal for stains because it sets up quickly and doesn't move. Marc Jacobs Cover (t) Stick Color Corrector This corrector color stick is great, making it ideal for the entire redness correction. The texture is creamy and mixed, and the color is warmer green, which will not choose through your foundation. It can be purchased at Sephora. The best peach-colored correctors are 1. Yves Saint Laurent Touche Eclat Neutralizer in Bisca This lightweight and creamy concealer comes in a gorgeous rose gold container, with an excellent built-in applicator. Its creamy texture is perfect for under the eyes, where it adjusts the blue tones and gives a touch of brightness. Take it from YSL Beauty, or Amazon. 2. Laura Mercier Eye Basics in Peach This color corrector is pretty cool because it takes the form of eye primer that is not too thick but will still work well with dark skin tones. Well, Lancome did it, and it's creamy, light, mixed, and and Ideal for under-eye circles because it will cover blue/purple bleaching without drying or settling into the crease. You can find it in Sephora. 2. Urban Decay Naked Skin Color Fixing Fluid in Deep Peach Light Stick Applicator, and creamy and nutritious formulas are hard not to like. This deep peach color corrector was formulated with darker skin tones in mind, so naturally this formula will be a winner, perfectly covering blue-based imperfections. Take it from Nordstrom. The best yellow correctors are 1. NYX Professional Makeup Concealer's Jar in Yellow A little on the thicker side, you can apply this yellow color corrector to neutralize red and purple tones. Its heavier formula can be evaporated with the foundation. The coating is flawless and lengthy, and the price is right, making it one of my go-to color correctors. Buy it on Amazon! 2. Makeup Forever Step 1 Leather Aligning Primer in yellow lighten the complexion while correcting redness with this yellow primer, which is perfect for warm skin tones. This will give your skin a glow, and will hide a multitude of sins. It's perfect for rosacea and redness, so go ahead and buy it from Sephora, or Amazon. The best lavender-colored correctors are 1. NYX Hi Definition Photo Concealer Wand's Lavender Blend A few drops of this lavender concealer into your foundation to combat saltiness, or apply it along your cheekbones to brighten things up. The texture is perfect, and the use with a wand is super easy. You can pick it up at Ulta, or Amazon. 2. Algenist Reveal concentrated color correction drops into blue So while technically blue hue, this color corrector still rocks when cancelling sallowness, and it's super-easy to use. Just mix the drop into your foundation, and apply it all over your face. Brighten complexion in an instant! These color correctors are available in Sephora and Amazon. Color Wheels: Let's start with some color theory Any novice makeup artist cherishes their color wheels for two reasons. The first is that it can tell you which Will stand out next to other colors, making it easy to bring out beautiful blue eyes with a touch of copper, or create striking eyeshadow/blush/lipstick combinations. The second reason is that the color of the wheel is also very important for correcting the color of makeup. The color correction wheel shows us how different colors are connected to each other. When it comes to color adjustment makeup, we specifically want to look for additional color pairs. These color pairs, when they are located next to each other, tend to bring each other out. However, when they are placed one on top of each other, they end up neutralizing each other. How do you figure out these extra colors? It's super simple! Choose one color and then draw a straight line from it to the color that is directly through it. You will see that green is the opposite of red, yellow is the opposite of purple, and blue is the opposite of orange. Green Is Correctors Since green is the opposite of red, green color correctors easily mask any redness on the face, whether it is red traces of acne, moles, sunburns, annoying pimple or rosacea. Yellow Color Correctors Being the opposite of purple, yellow color correctors can undo any under-eye dark circles, attractive veins and bruises, as well as perfectly evening and lightening your skin tone. Yellow correctors are great for olive skin tones and tans. Orange color correctors If you have been reluctant to use face sunscreen every time you walk out the door, and result in ending up with some dark spots and hyper-pigmentation on your face, orange color correctors can help you even out of your skin tone and create the perfect base for your makeup. Just keep in mind that orange color correctors are designed for those with darker skin tones, while those with lighter skin tones can only use them for contouring or to add a subtle sun kissed to the touch of their makeup. Peach color correctors While orange color correctors are best suited for dark skin tones, those with medium skin tones should opt for peach color correctors to hide any blue or purple spots, bruises and dark circles. Pink color correctors Similar to orange and peach color correctors, pink also covers blue-tinted spots, but it's perfect for light skin tones. You can use pink color corrector to mask dark circles around your eyes to eliminate any signs of fatigue from your face and make your skin look radiant and fresh. Pink color correctors also perfectly mimic olive and salt skin. Blue, Violet or Lavender Color Correctors Being the Opposite of Yellow, Violet Lavender color correctors undo the yellow spots, eliminate dullness from the yellow face and give a beautiful glow to it. Cancel redness with color correctors for different skin tones there are several types of redness you may experience. Your skin may be red because acne, because of sensitivity or rosacea, because of broken capillaries, or simply because your skin is a little red naturally. Very rarely the skin is really red, but rather, it is painted pink. If your skin is pale, especially if it has a cool subtext, pale green concealer is your best bet. Since green is the opposite of red (and pale green is the opposite of pink) on a colored wheel, it will do a magnificent job of lifting that redness, making your skin look evenly and flawless. When you use a green concealer to correct the color, trim your skin enhancements to the look with a little cream or liquid foundation and then powder. For medium and dark skin tones, especially for those with a warmer hue, a true yellow color correction concealer can work better than green. It will do just as well as work to neutralize redness in your skin, but it will also better fit in your base and the rest of your makeup. Erase these under-the-eye bags with color correctors Dark circles under the eyes come in a variety of colors. Look for that pigmentation before choosing the perfect color color color adjustment make-up. For purple-based under-eye circles that lean more towards red, you want to use a yellow color-correcting concealer. Yellow completely neutralize the purple, and decorate your under-eye area. If your skin is a little darker, sometimes yellow over dark circles can look ashy, so you can mix a little orange in a yellow concealer to get a total warm coating. For a more blue-based under-eye circles, that pale peach color is a correction masking your friend, especially if you have pale skin. For those with darker skin, a richer orange concealer will work even better because it will match the darkness of your skin and perfectly color to correct any discoloration. You can follow the color of the makeup correction on under the eye using just a little concealer or foundation and then a light layer of powder. Lighting Sallow Complex with color correctors So lavender color-correcting concealer should exist for a reason, right? Well, I admit that during nearly 10 years of working as a makeup artist, I've rarely seen the need to achieve a lavender concealer shade, but I'll still tell you what it's all about. This is usually the case with yellowness, when the skin is too yellow not in that gorgeous glowing way, but in an unhealthy way. Lavender primer can do a fantastic job of correcting the color without carrying too much color, but you can also A slightly heavier lavender concealer in your foundation. Since it requires the easiest application of color-correcting make-up, even a powder base is enough to finish off The best color makeup correction app is The Technique No matter what color you color correction, and no matter where the discoloration is, the application of color correctors is in itself about the same. Start with a cleaned, moisturized and primed face. Apply stains on your face that you need to paint correctly, and lightly apply the concealer, correcting the color, at points using fingers, or brush-concealer. Using either a mixing brush, fingers, or makeup blender, mix the color-correcting concealer until it sits over the skin in a very thin layer. Since the job of a color concealer is to neutralize rather than cover, you don't need to build up the coating. The thinnest layer is more than enough. Next, use a stippling technique to apply a foundation or concealer that matches the skin tone over the color of the corrected areas. It is best to use a liquid foundation. You want to touch the foundation on the skin so as not to disturb or remove the color correction makeup. To remove the excess foundation or mix it, gently press the sponge or beauty blender over it. The sponge will absorb the excess, keeping all your layers to the tact. If you like contouring and highlight with cream products, now is the time. - Finish with the dust of your favorite powder setting, and the rest of your makeup look. Color Correction Makeup Tips and Tricks - Mix your color correction concealer concealer with your base for a subtle shade and faster color makeup correction app. This method is ideal for correction across the face. If you are very pale with a cool tinge for your skin, the lavender concealer can work perfectly as a marker. If you are looking to correct a subtle color all over your face (such as redness or redness), tinted primer may be better than concealer. If you are looking to cover stains here and there like pimples or hyperpigmentation, then a cremation concealer is the best choice. For under the eyes, liquid concealer is usually better because they spread beautifully and keep under the eyes the area looks healthy and hydrated.
