Robert Wood Johnson, founder of Johnson and Johnson, was traveling by rail through the Rocky Mountains when he was in the making. The railway surgeon told him about the dangers of paving the way and the struggle to provide the injured railway workers with proper medical care. The train was often far from established medical centers or even from access to sterile medical supplies. Johnson saw the need to be filled. He consulted with other railway surgeons, and soon the first commercial first aid kit equipped railway surgeons to treat injuries of all kinds. The ingenuity of the set attracted people from all different lifestyles. From soldiers to celebrities, first aid kits are often used as the first resource to treat injuries throughout history. 1891 - The first ever common first aid kits are sold. 1898 - Pocket first aid kits are designed for soldiers in combat during the Spanish-American War. Earl Dickinson created it to help his wife Josephine protect the cuts and burns she received while cooking dinner. 1954 - The Band-Aid debuts on television in an advert for An Emergency Don't Wait, featuring comedian Imogene Coca. 1956 - First patterned patches, red-blue stars and stripes are sold. 1963 - Astronauts bring patches into space with them during their first trip to Mercury. 1987 - Johnson and Johnson become the founding partner of Safe Kids Worldwide, a global organization dedicated to preventing trauma in children. 2013 - To celebrate the 125th anniversary of first aid recruitment, Johnson and Johnson launch a childcare campaign in partnership with Safe Kids Worldwide and the actress Gyllenhaal. The campaign raises funds to accommodate more than 200 sports safety clinics to teach children about first aid readiness, how to deal with injuries and concussions and more safety needs.
