The waterproof JBL Charge 3 speaker features multiple buttons and lamps on top, as well as battery-condition headlights throughout the front deck. The power button lights up in white, blue or both to show the status of the Bluetooth speaker. There's also an access panel to the port in the back, which hides the USB charge in and out, as well as ancillary (AUX) in the ports. But here, we offer our JBL charge 3 button guide. We'll show you where the control buttons are on the speaker, what each button does, when to press them, and how to use them in general. JBL Charge 3 Buttons Guide Features, Descriptions and Location Bluetooth Discovery Mode Button There is one row of buttons on JBL Charge 3. Each button in this line has a unique shape. First, we have a Bluetooth detection button, next to the left side of the top of the speaker, as indicated on the green arrow in the next picture. Notice its squiggly shape. As you use the Bluetooth pairing button you will need this button anytime you pair the JBL charge 3 with never-before-paired Bluetooth buttons. So with this wireless speaker on, click this button to put this Bluetooth speaker into detection mode. When detected/paired mode, Charge 3 transmits its name and other connectivity information via bluetooth ether. This allows other nearby Bluetooth devices to detect and connect to it. JBL Charge 3 wireless speaker with its Bluetooth Discovery Mode button highlighted. JBL Charge 3 buttons. The volume down and up the JBL Charge 3 button also has volume controls. Near the center of the speaker near the Bluetooth button, the volume buttons are in the form of minus and plus characters. When pressed, they reduce and increase the output of the speaker by reducing or increasing the volume setting on the source Bluetooth paired device. See the Volume Down and Up buttons that the green arrows point to in the following picture. As you use the volume buttons with JBL charge 3 in pairs and playback, click minus the form to reduce the level of sound output from the speaker. Click plus-shaped to increase the output of the sound. Note that the volume controls have no effect when the speaker is not paired. In addition, the volume setting can vary from a paired device to a paired device. That is, each pair device remembers its own volume setting. So you may have to adjust the output of the sound when you unpair the speaker from one Bluetooth device and pair it to another. The Pause Play button / Pause has the shape of the right arrow and is next to the right side of the charge JBL 3, as indicated on the green arrow we drew in, in Figure. How to use the Play-Pause button Click on it to pause the sound playback. Click again to resume sound playback. Note that this is Mute button. That is, pausing playback thus suspends the playback of the sound on the source Bluetooth device to which this speaker is currently paired. When streaming, the stream is suspended. This way, you won't miss a single content when the speaker pauses, as the source device (your phone, tablet, or computer) remembers where the content was suspended. So it resumes playback in that location when you press the play pause button again. Paired with an Apple device, click the Play/Pause button to get Siri's attention. Please note that Siri must be enabled on the original device (phone, tablet) for this feature to work. JBL Charge 3 waterproof portable speaker. Show a dedicated Play-Pause button. The Power Power button not only turns JBL Charge 3 on and off, but also contains multicolored light to indicate the state of the speaker when turned on. How to use and interpret power button signals quickly press and release the power button to turn on the ON speaker or OFF. In addition, the power button lights up in different ways to indicate different states of speakers. First, it flashes blue when the speaker is not yet paired, and is in Bluetooth detection mode. It glows solid blue when the JBL Charge 3 is being successfully paired with a Bluetooth source device. See this blue glow in the next picture. JBL Charge 3 Bluetooth speaker, powered by, not paired. The display of the glowing white power button is highlighted. The power button glows solid white when the speaker is currently not paired and is awaiting a pairing request from the Bluetooth source device. See this glowing white button in the previous picture. Finally, the Power button glows pale blue and white while the speaker folds. The JBL Connect+ The Connect Plus button is used to connect two or more compatible JBL Connect speakers in party mode, so they all play the same audio content. As with speakers participating in Amazon's multi-100 music groups, all speakers participating in Connect are synchronized. That is, they all play the same sound at the same time. How to use the Connect Plus button, you press this button on every Bluetooth speaker you want to add to the Connect group. JBL Charge 3 button layout guide. JBL Charge 3 Power Bank Speaker. Display a dedicated -Connect Plus button. The image above shows a JBL 3 charging that is not participating in Connect because the Connect+ button is dark. However, the Connect+ button lights up when the speaker is connected to the Connect group. JBL Charge 3 Buttons Combination Codes Reboot Button Combination You can reset JBL Charge 3 on factory default settings and status by clicking on that And play/pause the buttons at the same time and hold them until a hard reset occurs. See these yellow buttons in the following picture. You may want to reset the speaker to correct any unsustainable or behaviors that you see from it, such as inability to pair, distortion of sound, inability to turn off when pressing the power button, and so on. Please note that the reset seems to invalidate any stored information about connecting to this speaker on the source Bluetooth devices. So you'll have to forget these connections and re-pair the speaker after resetting in order to play audio content through it again. JBL Charge 3 button layout guide. Serving only button mode Combination When in this mode, JBL Charge 3 is not turned on unless you connect the external USB power source. And then, it feeds without pressing the power button. Also, you can't turn it off in this mode unless you turn off the external power supply. Also, none of the buttons seem to work in this mode. The speaker will not be paired with any devices or other speakers, and as mentioned, the Power button does not turn off. To enable this mode, press the Connect and Volume UP buttons at the same time until the speaker powers off, usually taking ten seconds or so. You can enter this mode as long as the speaker is ON, and it doesn't matter whether it's connected to external power or not. But to turn this mode off, you need to connect the USB connection, as the speaker will not be turned on without it. Then, with the power button glowing, press and hold the connection and volume of the UP combination button for ten seconds or so until the power supply is off. This brings the speaker back to normal. JBL Charge 3 Battery Status Lights Gage This speaker is also equipped with numerous lights that show Bluetooth pairing status, power, and, the amount of charge currently built into the power bank battery. As read the state of the Gage battery When the internal battery is full, all five battery level lamps glow white. As the power bank discharges, fewer lamps glow. In the next image, the speaker is displayed at between 60 and 80 percent of the charge. Please note that four lamps are lit in this situation. JBL Charge 3 button layout guide. The JBL Charge 3 Bluetooth rechargeable Gage battery condition speaker is eighty percent of the full charge. As the battery further discharges, more battery level lights go out, until the amount of charge reaches between 0 and 20 percent. In this case, only one lamp glows, in the last picture on the left. Finally, when the battery discharges to a critically low level, the far left battery light flashes. Turning off the speakers is inevitable when it happens. There are a ton of inexpensive portable Bluetooth speakers available, but the high-end portable Bluetooth speakers that have come out recently are impressive. One such speaker is JBL Charge 3, which was released in May 2016. It's a waterproof portable Bluetooth speaker and a power bank all in one! The JBL Charge 3 waterproof portable Bluetooth speaker sells for \$145.93 comes in black, but you can also get it in blue, red, gray and aqua. For this price you better get the killer sound and perturbation of the battery, so let's take a closer look at what you get. Inside you have a 6000 mAh (22.2Wh) lithium-ion polymer battery that has up to 20 hours of music playback, and it can charge smartphones or tablets through the rear USB 5V/2 Amp charging port. When it comes to music you have two 50mm drivers, each with a 10W power rating and a frequency response of 65 Hz-20 kHz. Today we are looking at the JBL charge 3 in black, which is sold under the number of the part JBLCHARGE3BLKAM. Inside the retail box you'll find JBL Charge 3, 5V 2.3A USB power adapter, Micro USB cable and documents for the device (quick start guide, security and warranty cards). The bright orange color for the JBL wall charger and cable will help it get lost or leave behind when and on JBL charge 3 tubes, which is 8.4 inches long and about 3.5 in diameter. The portable speaker fits easily in one hand and is not too heavy at 1.76 pounds (800 grams). The controls for JBL Charge 3 are at the top, and you have the volume up and down, Bluetooth steam, power, play/pause, and a button to link this device to other JBL speakers. There is no miss button, but if you hit the play button twice as fast it will go to the next song. Charge 3 also has noise and echo-cancelling loudspeaker built-in, so answering calls from your speaker also works impressively Here's a look at the five lights at the bottom of the JBL 3 charge that allow you to visually see how much battery life you have. They light up gradually like 6000 mAh mAh recharge and let you know how much battery life is left if you're draining it by playing a lot or charging other devices. You can also tell you how much battery is left with the JBL Connect app. Each end of JBL Charge 3 has passive radiators to show you how powerful your speakers are! JBL Charge 3 is a pretty decently sized portable Bluetooth speaker, and it's just so going to have a great sound. You can crank up the volume and have no problem filling the large living room with good sound quality. Outside, the speaker loses a bit of its kick, but still the designs sound good distance valou you want to be within 30 feet of it. The good news is the Bluetooth signal will limit you to about 60-75 feet, and it helps to provide a good listening experience. On the back of JBL Charge 3 you will find a sealed lid (large rubber flap) over critical ports. This is necessary to assess the waterproofness of IPX7 speakers. To have an IPX7 rating, the speaker must be able to cope with immersion in water up to 1 meter deep for 30 minutes. We got our sample by the wet pool and in some light rain and never had any problems. JBL went with a micro USB port to charge the battery and eat along with a 3.5mm auxiliary jack and a USB 5V/2A port to power mobile devices. We noticed that the back of the device says that the USB input is 5v / 2.0 Amp, but the output for the charger is 5V / 2.3 Amp. Since the wall charger displays 15% more energy than the micro USB port is estimated for we asked JBL if there is anything to be concerned about and they said it was within the specifications. It takes about 4.5 hours to fully charge the battery. JBL Charge 3 offer some of the deepest and most powerful bass we've heard from a portable Bluetooth speaker. We found that the sound quality was better when it was placed on a flat surface, as in the image above. We strongly recommend giving JBL a charge of 3 addition if you happen to live near a target store in America. They have a series of JBL charge on display and you can try them out and compare them to other brands that may also be on display. The JBL 3 charge left us impressed, although Charge 2 also sounds pretty damn good after the latest firmware update. While JBL Charge 3 may not sound better for charging 2 owners it brings waterproofing to the table and more battery! With prices starting at \$145.93 supplied, the JBL charge 3 waterproof portable Bluetooth speaker may be higher than some want to pay for a portable speaker, but it sounds great! Well done!
