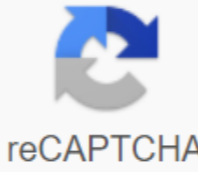


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Jesus gave Saint Faustina the Divine Mercy of Chaplet. Here are the steps of how to pray. Divine Mercy Pray Divine Mercy Chaplet at any time as an autonomous prayer, or pray for 9 days within the Divine Mercy of Novena. You can use regular rosary beads or fingers for this prayer. Step 1: Intro Prayer Make a Sign of the Cross and then say the following prayer: You have expired, Jesus, but the source of life has gushed forward for souls, and the ocean of mercy has opened up to the world. About The Pound of Life, the incomprehensible Divine Mercy, envelops the whole world and devastates Himself upon us. (Repeat three times) O Blood and Water that gushed from the Heart of Jesus as a source of mercy to us, I believe in You! Step 2: The first 3 prayers On the first 3 balls above the crucifix pray, one Oret, one Grad Mary and the Creed of the Apostles. Step 3: Eternal Father Of Prayer Then at first Grandfather The Father says Eternal Father of Prayer: Eternal Father, I offer you the body and blood, the soul and divinity of your dearly loved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in redemption for our sins and sins of the world. Step 4: The Sad Prayer of Passion After each prayer of the Eternal Father, at ten degrees Mary beaded to say the following prayer: For the sake of His sad passion, pardon us and the whole world. (Repeat steps 3 and 4 over the course of all five decades). Step 5: Prayer of the Holy God Say the prayer of the Holy God, repeated three times: Holy God, Holy Mighty, Holy Immortal, pardon us and the whole world. Step 6: The final prayer concludes with the final prayer: Eternal God, in which mercy is infinite and the treasure of compassion is an inexhaustible, kind view of us, and an increase in your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we cannot despair and disparege, but with great confidence to obey your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Day 1 (Good Friday) - All humanity, especially sinners Day 2 (Holy Saturday) - Souls of priests and religious day 3 (Easter Sunday) - All devout and faithful souls Day 4 (Easter Monday) - Those who do not believe in Jesus and those who do not know His Day 5 (Easter Tuesday) - Souls of separated brothers Day 6 (Easter Wednesday) - Meek and humble souls of children Day 7 (Easter Thursday) - Souls who especially revere and glorify the mercy of Jesus Day 8 (Easter Friday) - Souls who are in purgatory; Day 9 (Easter Saturday) - Showers that have become warm. Novena was to start on Good Friday and pray every day of Tridum and Easter Week in preparation for the glorious feast of Mercy, which was to take place on the eighth day of Easter (Sunday after Easter) (see Diary #1209-1230). During this novena, which Jesus himself discovered to Saint Faustina, he asks that every day be devoted to prayers for different groups of people. The Novena below comes from these private revelations of Saint Faustina, as recorded in her Diary of Divine Mercy. I wish that during these nine days you will bring souls to the source of My mercy, so that they can draw strength and refreshment there and all the graces they need in the hardships of life, and especially in the hour of death. Every day you will bring another group of souls to My Heart, and you will immerse them in this ocean of My grace, and I will bring all these souls into my Father's house. You will do it in this life and in the next. I will not deny anything to any soul you will bring to the source of My mercy. Every day you will beg My Father, for the power of My bitter Passion, for grace for these souls. Today bring me all MANKIND, especially ALL SINNERS, and immerse them in the ocean of My grace. Thus, you comfort Me in the bitter sorrow in which the loss of souls plunges Me. The most Merciful Jesus, whose nature is to have compassion for us and forgive us, not to look at our sins, but at our trust, which dedicate your infinite kindness. Take us all to the abode of yours Compassionate Heart, and never let us run away from Him. We implore you for your love that unites you with the Father and the Holy Spirit. On the omnipotence of Divine Mercy, The Salvation of Sinful People, You are a sea of mercy and compassion; You help those who treat you with humility. The Eternal Father, turn his merciful gaze to all humanity and especially to the poor sinners, all became bound into the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. For his sake, the Passion grieves to show us your mercy that we can praise the omnipotence of your mercy forever and forever. Amen Now pray Chaplet of Divine Mercy and Litany of Divine Mercy. It was they who gave me the strength to endure My bitter Passion. Through them, as through the channels my mercy flows to humanity. The most merciful Jesus, from whom all good comes, with the taking of your grace in the men and women dedicated to your service, so that they can do worthy deeds of mercy; and that everyone who sees them can glorify the Father of Mercy, who is in heaven. The fountain of God's love lives in pure hearts, bathed in the Sea of Mercy Shining like stars, bright as dawn. Eternal Father, turn your merciful gaze to the company of the chosen in your vineyard - the souls of priests and religious; and give them the power of your blessing. For the love of the Heart of your Son, to which they are imprisoned, give them your strength and light so that they can guide others on the path of salvation and sing in one voice the praises of your boundless mercy for centuries without end. Day 3 (Easter Sunday) Today bring me all DEVOUT AND FAITHFUL SOULS, and immerse them in the ocean of My Grace. These souls have brought me solace on the Path of the Cross. They were that drop of consolation in the midst of an ocean of bitterness. The most Merciful Jesus, from the treasure of your grace, You instilled in his graces in abundance to all and every one. Accept us into the abode of your Most Compassionate Heart and never let us escape from Him. We implore you for this very wonderful love for Heavenly Father, with which your heart burns so fiercely. Miracles of mercy are impenetrable. I don't just see them as a sinner. When you cast pity on us, you bring us all closer to your love. Eternal Father, turn your merciful gaze at the faithful souls as your Son's inheritance. For the sake of His sad Passion, give them your blessing and surround them with your constant protection. So let them never tolerate in love or lose the treasure of holy faith, faith, rather, with all the masters of the Angels and saints, may they glorify your boundless mercy for centuries to come. Amen. Day 4 (Easter Monday) Today bring me THOSE, WHAT DO NOT BELIEVE IN GOD and THOSE WHO DO NOT KNOW me. I also thought of them during My Bitter Passion, and their future zeal comforted my heart. Immerse them in the ocean of My grace. The most compassionate Jesus, You are the Light of the world. Receive in the abode of your Most Compassionate Heart of the soul of those who do not believe in God and those who do not yet know you. May the rays of your grace enlighten them that they too can extol your wonderful mercy with us; and don't let them escape from the abode, which is your Most Compassionate Heart. May the light of your love enlighten the souls in the darkness; Grant that these souls will know you and, with us, praise your mercy. Eternal Father, turn your merciful gaze to the souls of those who do not believe in you and those who do not yet know you, but who are enclosed in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. Draw them to the light of the gospel. These souls do not know how happy it is to love you. Grant that they too can extol the generosity of your grace for centuries. Amen. Day 5 (Easter Tuesday) Today bring me SOULS OF THOSE WHO HAVE FROM my church, and immerse them in the ocean of My Grace. During My Bitter Passion, they tore my body and heart, that is, My Church. When they return to unity with the Church, my wounds heal and thus they soften My Passion. The most merciful Jesus, Kindness itself, you do not give up the light to those who seek it from you. Receive in the abode of your Most Compassionate Heart of the Soul of those who have separated from your Church. Draw them with your light into the unity of the Church and do not allow them to escape from the abode of your Most Compassionate Heart; but bring it to the point that they too come to glorify the generosity of your mercy. Even for those who have torn the clothes of your unity, a source of mercy flows from your heart. The omnipotence of your mercy, Oh My God. Can bring these souls also out of error. Eternal Father, turn your merciful gaze to the souls of those who have separated from the Church of Your Son, who have squandered your blessings and abused your graces by persevering in their mistakes. Do not look at their mistakes, but at the love of their Own Son and at His Bitter Passion, which He has experienced for them, as they too are enclosed in His Most Compassionate Heart. Bring it that they can also glorify your great mercy for centuries. Amen. Now pray chaplet of Divine Mercy and Litany of Divine Mercy. These souls most resemble My Heart. They strengthened Me during My bitter agony. I saw them as earthly angels who would keep a vigil at my altars. I pour out streams of grace on them. Only a humble soul can receive My grace. I prefer humble souls with my confidence. The most merciful Jesus, you yourself said, Learn from me, for I am a meek and humble heart. Get in the abode of your Most Compassionate Heart all the meek and humble souls of young children. These souls send all paradise into ecstasy, and they are favorites of Heavenly Father. It is a sweet-smelling bouquet before the throne of God; God himself admires their aroma. These souls have a permanent abode in your Most Compassionate Heart, O Jesus, and they relentlessly sing the hymn of love and mercy. A truly gentle and humble soul is already here on earth, breathing the air of paradise, and in the aroma of its humble heart pleases the Creator himself. The Eternal Father, turn his merciful gaze to the meek souls, to the humble souls, and to the small children who are enclosed in the abode, which is the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. These souls bear the closest resemblance to your Son. Their fragrance rises from the ground and reaches your throne. Father of Mercy and All Kindness, I ask you for the love you carry these souls and the joy you receive in them: Bless the whole world that all souls together can sing the praises of your mercy for centuries. Day 7 (Easter Thursday) Today bring me SOULS WHO ESPECIALLY VENERATE AND GLORIFY MY MERCY, and immerse them in my mercy. These souls were most saddened by my Passion and entered most deeply into My spirit. These are living images of My Compassionate Heart. These souls will shine with particular brightness in the next life. None of them will go into the fire of hell. I will especially protect each of them in the hour of death. The most Merciful Jesus, whose heart is love itself, receives in the abode of your Most Compassionate Heart the souls of those who especially extol and honor the greatness of your mercy. These souls are powerful with the power of God Himself. Amid all the suffering and adversity they go forward, confident in your mercy; and united with you, O Jesus, they carry all humanity on their shoulders. These souls won't judge but your grace will hug them as they depart from this life. The soul that praises the kindness of its Lord is especially loved by Him. It is always close to a living fountain and draws grace from the Mercy of the Divine. Eternal Father, turn your merciful gaze to the souls who glorify and revere your greatest attribute, which is from your bottomless grace, and which are enclosed in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. These souls are living gospel; their hands are full of acts of mercy, and their hearts, filled with joy, sing to you, O All above! I ask you, O God: Show them Your mercy in accordance with the hope and trust they have placed on you. May they live up to the promise of Jesus, who told them that I myself would defend, as my own glory, in their lifetime, and especially in the hour of their death, those souls who would honor My bottomless mercy. Day 8 (Easter Friday) Today bring me SOULS WHO IN PURGATORY, and immerse them in the abyss of My Grace. Let the streams of My Blood cool their scorching flame. All these souls are very fond of Me. They are retribution to my justice. It's in your power to bring them relief. Draw all indulgences from the treasure of My Church and offer them on their behalf. Oh, if you only knew the torment they suffer, you would continually offer them the alms of the spirit and pay off your duty to my justice. The most Merciful Jesus, you have said yourself that you desire mercy; therefore I bring to the abode of your Most Compassionate Heart of Souls in Purgatory, souls who are very dear to you, and yet who must retribution to your justice. May the streams of Blood and Water that have poured from your heart extinguish the flames of Purgatory, so that there too can be celebrated the power of your mercy. From this terrible heat of the cleansing fire the plain rises to your mercy, and they receive comfort, refreshment, relief! In the flow of mixed blood and water. Eternal Father, turn your merciful gaze to the souls suffering in Purgatory, which are enclosed in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. I ask you, in the sad Passion of Jesus your Son, and throughout the bitterness with which His most sacred soul has been flooded: Show your mercy to the souls who are under your care. Look at them in no other sense, but only through the wounds of Jesus, your dearly beloved Son; for we firmly believe that there is no limit to your kindness and compassion. Amen. Day 9 (Easter Saturday) Today bring me SOULS WHO HAVE BECOME and dive into the abyss of My grace. These souls wounds my heart most painfully. My soul suffered from the worst disgust in the Olive Garden because of the warm showers. It was for this reason that I shouted, Father, get this cup from me, if it is your will. For them, the last hope for salvation is to run to My mercy. The most compassionate Jesus, you are Compassion Yourself. I bring warm souls to the abode of your Most Compassionate Heart. In this fire of your pure love, may these cool souls, who, like corpses, filled you with such deep disgust, will be on fire again. Oh, the Most Compassionate Jesus, exercise the omnipotence of your mercy and draw them into the heat of your love, and give them the gift of holy love, for nothing goes beyond your power. Fire and ice cannot be connected, either the fire dies or the ice melts. But by your grace, Oh God, you can extinguish all that is missing. The Eternal Father, turn your merciful gaze to the warm souls who are nevertheless enclosed in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. Father of Mercy, I implore you with the bitter Passion of your Son and his three-hour agony on the Cross: May they also glorify the abyss of your mercy. Amen.
