Advertising software generates revenue for its developer by automatically displaying ads in the software's user interface or on a screen that appears on the user's face during the installation process. The authors of the software, in turn, release patches and updates to get rid of known vulnerabilities and less likely to infiltrate malware. The databases of anti-virus software signatures are updated every day and new viral signatures are even more common. Adjust browser settings to block pop-ups and download plugins only when you click. Download and use uBlock Origin, Adblock or Adblock Plus extension/add-on to block third-party ads on websites. Don't just click on any link you see while browsing the web. This is especially true of links in comments, forums or messengers. often it's spam links. Sometimes they are used to increase traffic to websites, but often enough they will land you on pages that will try to execute malicious code and infect your computer. Links from your friends are also suspect: the person who shared the cute video may not know The page contains a threatening script. Don't download software from unverified websites. You can easily download a trojan (malicious software that pretends to be a useful application); or some unwanted programs can be installed along with the app. When installing free software or shareware, be reasonable and don't rush through the process. Choose a custom or advanced installation mode, look for checkboxes that ask for your permission to install third-party apps, and monitor them, read the End User Licensing Agreement to make sure nothing else is installed. Of course, you can make exceptions for apps you know and trust. If it is not possible to opt out of installing unwanted software, we advise you to cancel the installation completely. Fully.
