

Download While the Google Play Store has over a million apps that you can install on an Android device, the market sometimes removes popular software from its catalog such as Grooveshark Mobile and Adobe Flash Player. However, you don't have to download apps only from the official market; You can set up your device to download installation packages or APK files from elsewhere. To download a package from an email app and install it on Android, you need to download and use a third-party program. Open The Settings from the app screen or notification bar, and then tap Security. Scroll down to the device's administration and then check the Unknown Sources option. Download the attachment from your email app or mobile browser, and then open the Google Play Store from the Home or Apps screen. Search and then install Apk Installer Graphilos Studio from the Play Store. Open the app to complete the installation, and then review the folder containing the downloaded package. Select the APK file from the file manager, and then tap the Package Installer to start the setup. Follow the tips on the screen to install APK content on your smartphone. Open The Settings from the app screen or notification bar, and then tap Security. Scroll down to the device's administration and then check the Unknown Sources option. Download the attachment from your email app or mobile browser, and then open the Google Play Store from the Home or Apps screen. Search and then install Apk Installer by Array Infotech from the Play Store. Open the app when the installation is complete and then select the appropriate package from the list. Tap Set and then touch installing packages from a pop-up. Follow the tips on the screen to install THE APK on the device. Open Settings from the app screen or panel and then tap Security. Scroll down to the device's administration and then check the Unknown Sources option. Download the attachment from your email app or mobile browser and then open the Google Play Store from home or or or Screen. Search and then install Easy Installer from the Play Store. Open the app when the installation is complete, and then select the corresponding package from the list. Tap Set and then touch installing packages from a pop-up. Follow the APK on the device. The default source for Android 4.x apps is the Google Play Store, but Google restricts apps to certain phones based on location and known compatibility. In addition, some developers do not offer their apps in the Google Play Store and require you to manually download the Android Package (APK). Once the APK file is on your computer, transfer it to your phone to manually install the app using the Android App App App. Insert the smaller end of your Android USB cable into the USB port on your Android phone. Connect the other end of the usb charging cable to a standard USB port on your computer. Click Start and then click Windows Explorer. Double-click your Android phone from the Portable Devices section and then tap the SD Card button to access your phone's memory card. Drag and drop APK files anywhere on the SD map to move them. Click on the USB icon in the Windows 7 notification area and select Eject your android device before disabling the cable. If you don't see the USB icon, click on the small arrow to the left of the notification area. Chrome: Google's web version of the Play Store is convenient, but it's still missing a few features after all these years. The Google Play Store toolkit helps you fix a lot of minor issues to make it easier to use apps. Toolbox, created by the site Android Police, offers a lot of convenient settings. Specifically, in addition to the Set button, you'll also see a button for the APK Mirror. This site (which also belongs to Android Police) hosts APKs for apps that can't be downloaded yet. This is especially handy if you're sideloading an app that hasn't rolled out for everyone yet. You'll also see buttons for AppBrain (an alternative way to explore the Play Store) and Android police coverage for this app, if any. The extension will also show you if there is a beta version of the app available. Many companies run beta programs for their apps to check out new features before they roll out for everyone, but you have to find them on your own. This extension will now show you a handy link where you can subscribe to the beta version and download the most bleeding edge version immediately. Best of all, you can disable any Toolbox feature individually. So if you don't know or care about what AppBrain is, you can disable that button in the extension options. Google has just announced the launch of a new comprehensive cloud service called Google Play, which will include the former Android Market, Google Music and Google Ebookstore. From what we've seen Google Play is similar to iTunes, since it's designed to be a central depository for all your media and apps. However, you'll be able to access Google Play content from any device. For example, you can read books on your tablet and switch to your smartphone at any time. You'll be able to watch streaming movies or download them locally to watch them offline. The same goes for music. Google calls Play a digital entertainment destination where you can find, enjoy and share your favorite music, movies, books and apps online and on your Android phone or tablet. In other words, Google Play should be a single media destination that gives you everyone access to your music, videos, e-books or apps, whether you're accessing them from your smartphone, tablet, laptop or smart TV. How to set up a new Google account on your Android device On the moment you log into your Google account on your Android device, you're ready to start exploring the exciting world of Android apps, games and various other content through the Play Store app. Although its use is not exactly rocket science, we have nevertheless prepared a short guide to the topic that explains a few basic things you should know. These include how to download content, add a payment method, redeem a gift card, and more. Go to the section: How to search and download content? Finding a box is the place to start if you already know what you are looking for. It can be either a specific app like Android Authority or a category like racing games. Simply click on the top1 search box, enter query2 and click the search button to see all the results3. The alternative is category search. Simply click on the Category1 option while you're on the Play Store home screen and then choose what interests you.2 The third option is to view the content directly from the app's home screen. That's where you'll find things like apps and games recommended for you based on your recent activities, new and updated apps, top-rated games, and more. Check out the screenshots below to see how it looks in action. How do I download content? Once you find what you like, click on it1 to bring up more information. This includes item description, app rating, screenshots, videos, and, of course, the Set button. Click on it2 and wait for the device to make it magic. Once you've finished, you'll be notified that the content has been uploaded to your device and can be used: click on the notification or Open2 button. Keep in mind that some items in the Play Store are free, while you will have to pay for others. You'll need to add a payment method to your Google account to buy content from the Play Store, which we'll see in the next section. Step-by-step instructions: Search for content through a search box, category, or home screen. Click on the item (game, app, movie...) you like to bring up more information. Click Set to download content on Click the Open or Notification button to access the downloaded content. How do I add a payment method? Buy app, movie, game or any other Part of the content through the Play Store, you must add a credit/debit card to your account. The process is simple and takes only a minute or two. The first step is to launch the Play Store app and open a burger menu. You can do this by clicking the menu icon in the search box1 from above or swiping straight to the left side of the display. Then select Payment Methods2 and click on the Add credit or debit card button - as shown in screenshot number 3 below. The final step is to follow the instructions on the screen by entering the necessary details. Step by step instructions: Run the Play Store app and open the burger menu from the side. Click on the Payment Methods button. Click on the Add credit or debit card button and follow the instructions on the screen. While this is not mandatory, it is a good idea to include an authentication option for purchases. This means that you will have to approve every purchase you make in the Play Store with a password or fingerprint. This is a security feature that will make sure you won't buy something by accident. To turn it on, open the side menu, click on Settings1, select The Purchase Authentication Requires2, and then select one of the options

available3. Turning on fingerprint authentication is also a good idea. Step by step instructions: Bring up the menu from the side and click on Settings. Click on the Required Authentication button for purchases. Choose one of the options available. How do I update my apps and games? To try out the latest features that developers have added to their apps and games, you have to update them through the Play Store - although you can do so through your device's settings menu as well. To do this, run the Google Play Store app and raise the settings menu, either by clicking on the menu icon in the search1 box on top, or by swiping directly from the left side of the display. Then select my apps and games2 option, which will show you a list of those that can be updated. You can update each app individually or update them all at once. Step by step instructions: Start the Play Store app and bring the settings menu from the side. Click on My Apps and Games. Click on the Update button next to each app or select Update Everything to speed up the process. The alternative is for your device to update apps and games automatically, which is usually done while charging. To include this option, select Settings1 from the side menu, click on Auto-Update apps2 and select one of the options available3. Step by step instructions: Bring up the menu from the side and click on Settings. Click on the App Auto Update button. Choose one of the options available. How do I delete apps and games? Uninstalling apps and games that you no longer use is a breeze. Click on Menu in the search box1 from above to come up with a settings menu and select My Apps and Games2. Then just choose a pick open the app you want to get rid of3 and click on the Delete button shown in screenshot number 4 below. Wait a minute or so for the device to make it magic and the process is over. Keep in mind that multiple preinstalled apps cannot be removed from your device unless you have root access. These apps are usually from Google (YouTube, Gmail...), the manufacturer, or your carrier. Step by step instructions: Start the Play Store app and bring the settings menu from the side. Click on My Apps and Games. Click on Installed and select the app or game you want to get rid of. Click on the Delete button. How do I redeem a Google Play gift card? To redeem the Google Play gift card, bring the settings menu from the side, select the Redeem option and enter the code. That's all there is to it. The gift card amount will be applied to your account and can be used for purchases in the Play Store. You can check your balance at any time by heading to the account for the payment methods.
