Removal of packaging and inspection - After unpacking, make sure that the washing machine is not damaged. If in doubt, don't use a washing machine. Contact the service after the sale or your local retailer. Check that the accessories and supplied details are all present. Keep packaging materials (plastic bags, polystyrene parts, etc.) safe for children as they are potentially dangerous. If the device has been exposed to cold before delivery, keep it at room temperature for several hours before surgery. The washing machine is equipped with transport bolts to avoid possible damage to the interior during transportation. Before using the machine, it is imperative that the transport bolts are removed. After removing them, cover the holes with 4 closed plastic caps. Install the washing machine and remove the protective film from the control panel (if it is available on your model). Move the device without lifting it on the countertop. Place the device on a hard and level surface of the floor, preferably in the corner of the room. Make sure all four feet are stable and rest on the floor, then make sure the washing machine is perfectly level (use the spirit level). In the case of wooden or so-called floating floors (e.g., certain parquet or laminated floors) place the device on a sheet of plywood 60 x 60 cm thick at least 3 cm thick, which is fixed on the floor. Make sure that the vents at the base of the washing machine (if any on your model) do not interfere with the carpet or other material. Turn off the device and check the filter. If necessary, remove any lock. The location of the filter is different depening on the model. It is also possible that there is a special lever to open the door. If these options do not help, the last option is to disable the device for 30-60 minutes and try to open the door after that.
