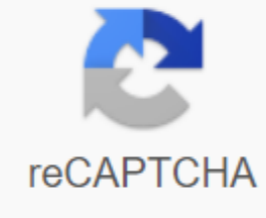

Oyedepo (born 27 September 1954) is a Nigerian missionary, Christian author, entrepreneur , the architect and founder and presiding bishop of the Faithchurch Cathedral in Ota, Ogun State, Nigeria, and the Church of the Faith live around the world, also known as winners [should cite] Winners' Chapel's international church network located in more than 300 cities, in all states of Nigeria and in several cities in 45 African countries , Dubai, United Kingdom and United States. Oyedepo has been considered one of the pioneers of the charismatic Christian movement in Africa and has been called one of the most powerful preachers in Nigeria. [to quote] He is the President of Covenant University and Landmark University. He was named Nigeria's richest pastor by Forbes magazine in 2011. [1] Originally on 27 September 1954, David Olaniyi Oyedepo was born in Osogbo, Nigeria, but is of Omu-Aran descent, Irepodun Local Government Area of Kwara State. He grew up in a mixed religious family. His father, Ibrahim, was a Muslim healer. His mother, Dorcas, was a member of the Order of the Cherubim and Seraphim Movement Church (C&C.; S), a branch of the Aladura movement in Nigeria. [to quote] He was raised by his grandmother in Osogbo, who introduced him to the virtues of Christian life through the early morning prayers she attended with him. She also taught him the importance of tithing. Oyedepo was again in 1969, through the influence of his teacher, Betty Lasher, who took an interest in him during his high school days. He studied architecture at Kwara State Polytechnic University, Ilorin and worked briefly with the Federal Department of Housing in Ilorin before resigning to focus on missionary work. Oyedepo received his Ph.M. in human development from the University of Honolulu, Hawaii, USA. According to him, he received a mission from God through an 18-hour vision in May 1981, to liberate the world from all the oppression of the devil through preaching the word of faith. [2] This was the first vision that led to the founding of the World Wide Living Faith Church (LFCWW), first known as the Liberation Faith Time, in 1981. Two years later, on 17 September 1983, the Pastor Enoch Adeboye, Superintendent of the Redeeming Christian Church of God, ordained David and his wife, Florence Abiola Akano (known as the Abiola Oyedepo Faith) to become pastors and officially commissioned the new church. Five years later, Oyedepo was ordained bishop. Living Faith Church (AKA Winners Chapel International) started in Kaduna but moved to Lagos, Nigeria's former capital in July 1989, to start a new branch of the church after Oyedepo claimed to have received instructions from God to reach the people of Lagos. Oyedepo is the wealthiest missionary in Nigeria with a net worth of over \$150 million. The church owns four private jets and several buildings, including in London and the United States. Oyedepo is an author and journalist who has written more than 70 headlines in addition to periodicals. He is the president/publishing house of Dominion Publishing House (DPH), a publishing arm of the ministry. DPH has over 4 million prints in circulation to date. Via Oyedepo; Covenant University, the Faith Institute and the Uk Heritage Model School have been established to equip youth with global impact. The construction of a third university named Crown University was underway, located in Calabar, Cross River, Nigeria. [3] In 1998, Oyedepo announced he had been ordered by God to build a new facility for the Commission to match the growing number of followers. This led to the Oyedepo church's acquisition of the original 530-angst (2.1 km2) facility, known as Canaanland, acting as its headquarters. It is home to a 50,000-seat auditorium, the 'Makeshift House of Faith', believed to be the largest church auditorium in the world. [4] This is a feat also recorded by the Guinness Book of Records. [5] Faith Tabernacle was reported to be the largest Church Auditorium in the world in December 2005 The construction was completed within 12 months. Reports also claim that the building was built without debt. [6] The 50,000-seat residence was reserved on 18 September 1999, under former President Olusegun [8] Canaanland is located in Ota, Ogun State and is a 5,000 acres (20 km2) of real estate and campus, has a 50,000-seat auditorium, church clerk, church youth chapel, an elementary school called the Kingdom Heritage Model School, a full boarding missionary high school called Faith Academy, with over 1,500 students and covenant University facilities – containing more than 7,000 students , full residence in extremely modern dormitory facilities - with fully equipped faculty buildings and many staff housing facilities. The Canaanland campus also has for-profit church-run facilities such as bakeries, bottled water processing plants, gas stations, many restaurants and shopping shops, some providing housing for more than 2,000 church and guest house employees. Four banks are also present on this property, three of which are branches of external commercial banks and one of which is a community and micro-finance bank and run by the Church. The entire of Canaanland including 15,000 proposed housing estates known as the City of Canaan rose to 17,000 acres in 2012. [10] The largest annual meeting of the Shiloh Ministry, held every December in the same Faith Auditorium and often welcomes thousands of congregations around the world. The Christian Ministry The teachings of Oyedepo have included him in the genre of what is commonly known as the Word of Faith Movement. [11] He mentioned the main exponents of the Faith Movement such as Kenneth Copeland, Gloria Copeland, Kenneth Hagin, E. W. Kenyon, T. L. Osborn, Smith Wigglesworth as well as prominent Nigerian preacher, Enoch Adeboye and the late Benson Idahosa as advisors. [13] As with many of his influences, Oyedepo has been described as a preacher of the prosperity gospel. [16] Winners Chapel International runs a Bible training program called the Word of Faith Bible Institute for members and non-members to develop knowledge of Christian principles as well as develop future leaders and pastors. The Institute is run in the main branches of the Church. [17] Oyedepo is president of David Oyedepo Ministries International (DOMI). [18] DOMI is an umbrella organization that includes the Living Faith Church World Wide (a global network of churches), the World Mission Agency (WMA); the global missionary arm of church activities, Dominion Publishing House; publishing arm of church, Covenant University, and Social Development Mission projects – ever hospitals, maternity homes, schools, etc. Oyedepo has criticized corruption in Africa as a whole and poor leadership in government. [19] The church of Oyedepo also runs its own publishing house, called Dominion Publishing House (DPH), which was commissioned on 5 December 1992, having published more than 70 Christian books, inspiration and motivation, book, magazine and other resources.
