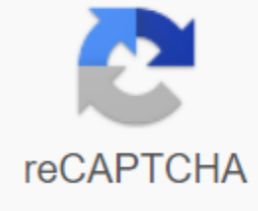

[5] Opened in 1999, the southeast portion of the Pocatello/Chubbuck School District serves #25, and is the newest of the district's three traditional high schools. Residents of Idaho State University properties housing university students with dependent children, [6] McIntosh Manor (Building #57), [7] [8] Drawing Courts #57 #53 High School building <3> [9] [10] and Edge Ridge Townhomes (building #54), [8] [11] are zoned to Century High School. [12] Athletics Century competes in athletics in IHSAA Class 4A, the second highest class in the state. It is currently a member of the Great Basin (East) Conference, with Pocatello and Preston. The volleyball team won the national title for the third time in a row in the fall of 2012. The football team won three state 4A titles in four seasons from 2000-03, [13] as the girls soccer team (2003-06). Inspired by the timing, officials called the new facility Century High School. That same year, major additions and renovations were completed at the city's other two high schools, namely Highland High School (1963) and Pocatello High School (1892). Century is the first impressive building that travelers on the north side will see from the highway as they enter the city limits. Located on the southern edge of the city, Century stands on highly visible real estate east of I-15.
