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In a recent notice, the MPSC announced the revision of MPSC Mains Syllabus 2020. This revision was included in the I-IV General Research Document. No changes were made to Document 1 (Marathi and English - Essay/Translation) and to Document 2 (Marathi and English - Grammar/Understanding). The Commission made changes to the w.r.t exam model to negative marking in the objective type of questions. Against the 1/3 negative markings that were previously assigned to every wrong response, the commission has now allowed negative markings of 25% or 1/4 of the total number of stamps, for each incorrect answer. Exams are conducted and monitored by the Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC).
