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I needed to upgrade my old kitchen base closet to the drill press basket, so I built myself a new one. I made this cabinet to meet my requirements of space and size. Feel free to adjust the sizes wherever you see fit to meet your needs. Do you have drilling equipment in different locations, so you have to go back and forth from your drilling press to complete the work? Well then it's a project for you. This drilling press room allows me to keep absolutely everything related to drilling in one convenient place. If I ever need to lower the press desk, all I have to do is move the closet out of the way and slide it back into place when I'm done. Before starting this project, make sure that the base of your drilling press will match between the sides of this cabinet. In this case, you need to make adjustments to the design. Make the most of the cuts to kick cut outs using a circular saw and then finish the incisions with a hand saw. So far, both sides have been identical. When cutting rabbet and dado make sure which side, which side. I used a dado blade set to cut 3/4 of the rabbet at the top of each side and 3/4 dado just above the cut leg. These abbreviations will be hidden in the final assembly don't hesitate to use a full 3/4 cut without worrying about the actual thickness of the plywood being a little smaller. This step is quite simple since you are cutting rectangular pieces of pieces upper and lower parts to the sizes shown. Cut back to the sizes shown. Cut a piece of impact in flash to the size shown. Put one side down on a flat surface. Glue and Brad top and bottom in the rabbit and dado aside making sure the front edges of the top and bottom are flush with the front edge of the side. Be careful that you have the upper and lower parts in the correct orientation as they are almost square. Using a large right angle, make sure the upper and lower parts are close to the square to the side and let the glue dry. Once the glue dries, glue and brad on the other side of this assembly, again making sure that the front edges of the top and bottom are flush from the front of the other side. Again, using a large angle at right angles make sure the assembly is square and let dry. Once the glue dries and after making sure that the assembly is perfectly squared, glue and brad the back of such a top edge of the back flush with the top surface of the top and bottom edge of the rear of the flush with the bottom surface of the bottom. The back should be centered between the two sides of the pieces. I hid all the front edges of the plywood, adding 3/4 to 3/4 red oak stripes. I used square strips so I could use a cookie joiner to attach them. Alignment is much easier with cookies and less risk of more grinding laminate plywood. I used red oak because I have a lot left to scrap from other jobs. Glue and Brad piece hitting the fri between the strip at the bottom of where you need to make sure the dimensions in the picture will work for your press drill and adapt as needed. Cut the top to the sizes. Add 1 x 1 oak strips at the front and sides with cookies. The cookies will make it easier to align the strip with the top edges. Place the top on the cupboard. When it is in position, only the stripe should be visible at the front and sides of the bottom (see image). Using a pencil, not to cover the location of the sides and front, drawing a line from above on the saw table, set at 1/4 width, 1/4 depth and 1/4 of the fence. Cut the dadoes in the back of the sides. Set up the dado blade, set at 1-shire, 1/2 depth. Use the sacrificial fence so that the blade sticking out of the fence 3/4. Cut rabbets on the sides of the front front This next step you will need a high auxiliary fence that allows you to stand on the board on the edge of the table saw. I'll be producing Instructable soon showing you how to do it. Set up a dado blade set at 1/4 width, 1 depth and 1/4 in from the auxiliary fence. Cut the slots on the sides of the front. There are 3 boxes and they are collected exactly the same. Glue and Brad sideways to the front of making sure the tops flush (image 1) and grooves for the bottom to align (image 2). Slide the bottom of your back along the groove into the lateral parts until the bottoms are in the groove in front. Insert the back of the top. It should come to rest on the bottom and the rear edge of the bottom should be flush with the back surface of the back (image 3). Add a drawer pulls at will. The vertical distance between the boxes is 1/8, and between the boxes and the top/bottom is 1/8. The roller coaster boxes I used were 1 7/8 high. Installed the bottom drawer slides so that the bottom of each slide is 1/8 above the inside of the bottom of the cabinet. The mountain next slide steam box height is 8 3/4 plus 1/8 interval or 8 7/8 above the first pair. Repeat for the last pair of slides. Draw the central lines on each side of the box 15/16 above the bottom of the drawer. Mount each of the boxes onto the slides using the central line as a guide. This space cabinet nests around a column of drill press standing on the floor, restoring storage for your drilling bits and other small accessories. A large storage space behind the doors hides bulky items. In addition, the device rolls out of the way on the casters, so you can lower the table when needed. Benchtop drill press park is comfortable on top, and with cutouts left in place, the cabinet is ready to go to the floor of the standing model when you're in.
