The Sagrada Familia project began in 1882 and more than 135 years later, it is still unfinished. Designed by Catalan architect Antoni Gaudi, Sagrada Familia has tall towers, intricately designed facades and draws inspiration from nature with fruit motifs, shells and angular pillars inside that create the effect of standing under a canopy of majestic forest. The stained glass windows, divided into shades of red, blue, green and and ohra, creates a magnificent spectacle when sunlight pours through colorful fragments of glass. An architectural marvel, Sagrada Familia attracts more than 4.5 million visitors a year and is the most visited monument in Spain. Only small bags and backpacks can be temporarily stored while visitors go up in the towers. For security reasons, suitcases cannot be stored at the venue. Are wheelchairs available?
