

(Approved by the Data Council 4/10/96) Most of DHHS's responsibilities are related to the production, collection, aggregation, analysis and dissemination of health data and information. DHHS uses data generated internally and by various private and government agencies. The existence and application of national and international standards for the format, content and exchange of health data and information can improve the effectiveness and effectiveness of the Department's activities. More importantly, the widespread use of uniform health data standards in the United States can improve the cost-effectiveness of health care and make it much easier to collect and aggregate public health and research data. Widely adopted standards also contribute to the development of compatible commercial information products useful to society and government. As a major U.S. health insurer, regulatory body, public health authority, manufacturer and research sponsor, health care provider, statistical and information services agency, and de facto content standards manufacturer, DHHS has a significant impact on health care requirements and practices, public health and health research. The Department's objective is to use this influence to promote the development, maintenance and use of health data standards that meet the needs of society as a whole, as well as its internal needs. To this end, the Department works as a partner of the private health sector, public health communities and research, as well as other federal, state and local agencies, in developing and maintaining robust, consensus-based standards for format, content and transmission of health data and information, takes on different roles in the development, implementation and maintenance of different standards, depending on the availability and effectiveness of existing standards-making efforts. At any moment the table will be overflowing with fragile cargo. This is not the predicament in which you expect to find an executive software such as Turak. But again, how many managers regularly take time to work at the monastery poultry farm? Just at the very last moment, one of the Abbey brothers quietly steps in and helps get the egg piling up under control. The gesture reminds 47-year-old Turak, president of The North American company MuTek Solutions Inc., a software development firm, of why he keeps returning to Mepkin Abbey. Attitude How can I help the community? and how can the community help me? He's talking. The monastery might be the last place you would learn about running a fast company. And, in fact, the excitement in the egg house aside, there's actually nothing quick about life in Mepkin. The tempo here is deliberate, the graph is predictable, and the setting is removed. Located 45 miles from Charleston, North Carolina, the monastery is located on more than 3,000 acres of peaceful lowland in Berkeley County, among the state's living oaks draped with Spanish moss. But a closer look reveals the operations that most corporate managers will envy - one with motivated employees, a strong organizational culture, and no backstabbing. And talk about the track record: Mepkin is part of the Cistercian Order, which was founded in France more than 900 years ago. Work is an integral part of the faith of these monks. It refreshes the body and mind for more intense periods of prayer and contemplation, says Father Francis Kline, 51, abbot of Mepkin. The independent monastery has also racked up some impressive sales: its chicken farm generates annual revenue of more than \$500,000, producing about 9 million eggs and 270 tons of compost per year. The rest of the operation includes guest houses for 1,000 or so annual apostates, a 2,200-acre timber business, a website and gift shop, and a recently expanded botanical garden (which will open to the public early next year). Mepkin's revenue supports disadvantaged locals in addition to covering the abbey's operating costs. Not bad for two dozen monks (average age: 70), whose prayer regime allows only six hours of work a day. How does so little reach so much? Working with almost no distractions, a bit of politics, and no out-of-control ego, says brother Stan Gumula, 58, Abbey's business manager. Because monks have always trust in each other, they are not afraid to admit mistakes. The rule of reverence: the sooner you can identify a problem, the faster it can be resolved. It's exactly the kind of trust and personal responsibility that more businesses need, says Turak, who lives in Raleigh, North Carolina and visits Mepkin several times a year. Fearing the consequences of their mistakes, workers often try to hide their mistakes - a practice that eventually comes back to haunt them. The monks understand that something doesn't always work, Toorak said. As the saying goes: It's in nature eggs break down. This is the type of open atmosphere that Turak encourages among his sales crew at MuTek. You feel safe enough to tell me about your mistake, he says, and if only confirms my confidence in you. Of course, profit is not the main motive in Mepkin Abbey. There is service to God. This mission is reinforced by daily tasks and rituals that are sacred and mundane: 3:20 a.m. church service, silence from 8 p.m. to 8:30 a.m., even shovel chicken manure into compost piles. All that monks demonstrate their divine service and strengthen their community. If the mission provides clarity, compassion is the key to the harmony of the monks. Even the common man falls seven times a day, said brother Callistus Kraylow, 51, a former Wall Street computer technician. If you believe in it, you forgive others for their shortcomings. The commitment to such a humble reality is what binds this eclectic group - which includes a former clinical psychologist, chef, stage manager, and fisherman - and binds them together for life. It shouldn't work. Says Kline says. The fact that we are here and that we are one says a lot about God. Mepkin's ethos is one that is overworked, IPO-hungry entrepreneurs are sure to find learning. I think they can get a completely different view of life and values other than making money, says Brother Gumula. The monastery has a lot to teach, just showing people how we live. The way monks live also says a lot about how they treat their clients. Gumul's brother has just called a Florida woman, carefully answering her many questions about the proper use of compost on houseplants. It's a long conversation - especially for the S7 order. (Providing quality and providing first-class customer service often requires patience, well, monk.) But Brother Gumul believes that this time is not wasted. It's not just that we want people to go back for another sale - we do. But they deserve to open boxes of eggs and not find shredded eggs or smears of manure. What would that say about this place? Although the company and the monastery are fundamentally different from each other, the sense of fairness and loyalty of the monks is good business and good for business, says Turak. And their view of work is healthy: It's designed to provide us with food, clothing and safety so we can do other things in our lives, he says. This is something that monks never lose sight of.
