The Galaxy J5 is a Samsung smartphone that arrived in Brazil in August 2015 and can now be purchased at a low price. With values between R\$500 and R\$600, the phone offers a front-facing flash and competent rear camera, as well as interesting specs for the incoming phone. However, low RAM can cause a slowdown, especially when it comes to the phone used. If your J5 hangs, the alternative is to reset the device to factory settings. The procedure removes all data and settings made by the user, leaving the phone new. See the next step-by-step guide, like the Samsung phone format and improve its performance. Below are the steps you should take if you decide to return your phone by default. There are two ways to reset or reset the Galaxy J5 hard. The first can be done easily through the settings menu. However, if your phone is unlikely to react, or if settings become unavailable, you may still find it difficult to reset the J5 with a combination of hardware buttons. If you wish, click The Backup Time for my data to move the slider to ON or OFF. If you wish, tap Restore to slider in ON or OFF. Tap Factory data reset. Click Reset Reset You have a lock screen enabled, enter a PIN or password. Click Continue.Tap Delete Everything. Here's how you reset using hardware buttons to turn off the device. It's important. If you can't turn it off, you'll never be able to download recovery mode. If you are unable to turn off your device regularly with the power button, wait until your phone's battery is drained. Then charge your phone for 30 minutes before loading into Recovery Mode. When the device logo displays the screen, release only the power key When the Android logo displays, release all the keys (installing the system update will show about 30 - 60 seconds before showing the settings of the Android Recovery menu). Click the Volume key down several times the key to highlight the wipe data/reset plant.'Click the power button to choose. Press Volume Down until you highlight Yes - delete all user data. Click the Power button to select and start master reset. When the master reset is complete, the Reboot System is now stand out. Press the power key to restart the device. How do I reset the Samsung Galaxy J5 and remove the lock password from the screen? This tutorial has steps for you to recover the Galaxy J5 or turn it off. After completing all the steps, your Galaxy J5 will return to its default factory with a new Android and proto that will be configured again. Rebooting a mobile phone can usually be done for a variety of reasons. Poor performance caused by bugs, failures, endless cycles, some kind of virus, or other related

problems. If these are the reasons, they will be easily excluded from the system. However, the process will also remove all your personal data from your phone, such as photos, videos, music, apps or any changes you make. This is also good for those who will sell or get rid of the phone, thus leaving the device clean for their new owner. Below are the precautions that need to be taken before and then take steps to reset the Galaxy J5. Read before resetting your phone: Steps in this tutorial can be used in the next Samsung mobile phone model: Galaxy J5 SM-J500, J500M, J5 2016 J510, J510MN. Make sure you have saved from your phone's internal memory photos, audio, that is all the files that are important to you. To do this, save a memory card, computer/laptop, or other compatible device. Write down your Google account details that are currently linked to your phone. This information will be requested after the reset during the Android settings. Also remember that you will have to manually update some apps after you reset your phone. Before you start Remove the chip and memory card from the device. The battery must be at least 50% charged. Care! Hard Reset erase everything on your Samsung Galaxy J5 and you won't be able to recover anything if you back up your data time. How to reset your Samsung Galaxy J51 phone - First you have to turn off your phone. Then press and hold the VOL, Home and Power button at the same time.2 - When the Samsung logo appears on the screen, release all the buttons and wait to access the screen.3 recovery mode - On the screen with the robot installing the system update, Do nothing, wait to go to Android Recovery screen.4 - On the menu screen, use the VOL- go to wipe the data/factory reset option, and then confirm by clicking the Power.5 button - On the next step, click VOL- until you highlight Yes - remove all custom version data Wait until the phone's internal memory is formatted.6 - Next to the finish line select Reboot system now and click. What do we do now? Wait until the Galaxy J5 restart on the welcome screen and then follow the instructions to complete the process. How to reset the Samsung Galaxy J5 connected for those who do not want to lose stored data on the phone, the best option is to make a recovery with the device included. Here's how it's done! Use your phone to click the Settings button. Then back and reset. Now under the Restoration of the Plant by default. Then click the Reboot or Reboot button. Enter the password if requested on the next screen. And finally, click ERASE ALL. The Galaxy J5 will be restarted automatically to complete the formatting process. You should keep in mind that resetting or returning to a state factory in a mobile phone removes all of its contents, so you should back up your data before doing so if you don't want to lose everything. There are two ways to make a reset on the Samsung Galaxy J5 Prime one through mobile options and the other more complete from recovery mode. Recovery from Samsung Galaxy J5 Prime options If you want to reset using device options to go back to Samsung Galaxy J5 Prime state you should follow these simple steps: 1-first step: Access to the menu settings of your Samsung SM-G570M device, SM-G570F, this icon cogwheel. 2- Second step: Scroll down Samsung Galaxy J5 Prime settings to the bottom where you'll see a section called The System, click to continue. Step 3: If you see a section called Advanced Click to display the extended versions of the Samsung Galaxy J5 Prime. 4- Fourth Step: Click on the reboot options from this section this will allow us to restore network options, apps or reset Samsung Galaxy J5 Prime completely. 5- Fifth Step: Click on the last option called Erase All Data (Factory Reset) or simply reset the data factory. Step 6: The first confirmation reminds you that all your data will be deleted from this device, the data you've uploaded to Google, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, or backups that you have in the cloud, such as Google Drive, Dropbox or One Drive, will not be deleted. Click the Reboot button. Step 7: A second confirmation message will appear indicating that all information stored on the Samsung Galaxy J5 Prime and all downloaded apps will be erased and reminding you that this action cannot be cancelled. If you agree, click on the Erase Everything button. 8th Step: If necessary, draw a screen unlock pattern or enter a screen unlock password or PIN to continue. Step 9: Samsung's Galaxy J5 Prime device will restart and take a few minutes to start when the device is restored to its factory state and the application optimization pre-installed in the Android 6.0.1 operating system (Marshmallow). Video Recovery instructions with hard reset or recovery mode Samsung Galaxy J5 Prime can solve problems that have not been solved with a normal factory restart. 1- First, turn off the Samsung Galaxy J5 Prime completely. If you can't unlock the screen, press and hold the power button for 20 seconds and the phone will shut down. 2- Keep the volume down and the keys power together for a few seconds. In some devices according to the Android version, the combination can be a power key and a volume key up. 3- When the Samsung logo is displayed, release the buttons. 4- Move through the menu with volume up and volume down the keys until you reach the recovery mode option and press the power button to access. If the device's menu is displayed in Chinese characters, click here to see how to reset your mobile phone in Chinese 5- Use the volume up and volume down keys to choose to destroy the cache section of the option and click the power button to activate the option and clear the mobile cache. 6- Through Seconds you will return to the previous screen, with the volume buttons go to the option to wipe the data/reset plant and press the power button to enter. A screen with lots of NOs and YES will appear, with Volume keys again go to YES and press with the power key. 7- After finishing again with volume keys, click on the restart system now and press the power key of your Samsung Galaxy J5 Prime, the device will restart and take a few minutes to start when the device is restored to its factory state and optimize applications pre-installed in the System Android 6.0.1 (Marshmallow).
