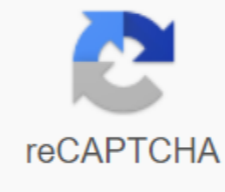

Products containing hydroquinone are best tested in a small area, since some people are allergic to it. If you are allergic to hydroquinone, you can benefit from the use of products containing kojic acid instead. Kojic acid Kojic acid is also a medicine for the treatment of pigmentation problems and age spots. Discovered in 1989, kojic acid works in the same way as hydroquinone.
