The transcript(s) of your major license may be from any discipline, but acquiring strong skills in understanding reading, writing and analysis is encouraged. Your licenseGP provides the Admissions Committee with an indicator of academic performance. Our Admissions Committee analyses the transcripts in detail, looking for trends and the type of degree, the depth and rigor of the completed courses. If you have mitigating circumstances that have affected your academic performance, include an addendum to your personal statement. Your diploma may be in progress at the time of application, but must be completed by the start of law school. The credential assembly service is the compensation center for The LSAT score(s), transcripts, and ratings. You can also apply to any ABA accredited law school through this website. LSAT or GRE We accept either LSAT or GRE, as long as the score has been obtained within five years of the expected date of entry into law school. The LSAT score, together with the cumulative average of the bachelor's degrees, is among the main considerations for admission to the Faculty of Law of the University of Dayton. LSAT is designed to test the understanding of reading, analytical reasoning and logic. However, all portions of your application are taken into account by the Admissions Commission. GRE We will also accept GRE for admission. If you apply a GRE score, you must also register with the Accreditation Assembly Service (CAS) through the Law School Admissions Council (LSAC). In addition to the GRE score, the remaining application materials, including transcripts, transcripts, recommendation, personal declaration, CV and optional declaration on diversity -- must be submitted to the CAS. If you also took LSAT, that score will be part of the CAS file. While applicants only need to take LSAT or GRE, we will consider all scores if you take both tests. If you have taken LSAT, we consider it to be the primary admission test, regardless of whether you have submitted a GRE score. Law school requires at least two professional letters of recommendation from people who can comment on the substance of your academic or employment file. We recommend academic references if possible. Letters must be sent by recommendations to the LSAC. Applicants should be aware that all jurisdictions control applicants on character and fitness issues before allowing them to be allowed to practice law in the jurisdiction. In addition to a bar exam, there are character, fitness, and other qualifications for admission to the bar in every U.S. jurisdiction. Applicants are encouraged to set the requirements for any jurisdiction in which they intend to apply for admission by contacting the jurisdiction. Addresses for all relevant agencies are available through the national conference of Bar Examiners. Your personal statement should highlight the interest and motivation of the law school. We also want you to tell us why you think you are a good candidate for law school and, ultimately, the practice of law. The statement should provide our admissions committee with additional information about you and provide a basis for assessing your writing ability. The declaration should be one to three pages long.
