Smathers of the University of Florida is one of the largest university library systems in the United States. The system includes eight of the nine University of Florida libraries and provides key support to all academic programs except those presented by the Lawton Chiles Law Information Center. Previously the Health Sciences Centre Library was also separate, but it was integrated into the Smathers Library on 1 July 2009. [4] The current dean is Judith C. Russell. All libraries serve all faculty and university students, but each has a special mission to be the main support of certain colleges and degree programs, with Marston becoming the favorite library. As usual in the research library, library materials are placed in various locations depending on discipline. The three largest libraries cover a variety of disciplines while the smaller library focuses on three or fewer disciplines. George A. Smathers Library and Dean Russell Library West's collection are one of the main Libraries in the George A. Smathers Library System. It holds collections in humanities and social sciences, including resources supporting Warrington Business College, African Studies, East Asian Area Studies, and isser and Rae Judaica Price Library. The library completed a \$30 million renovation in December 2003 that doubled its capacity, better information technology, and added Starbucks to the lobby. This collection contains legal research materials that support state, federal, and international legal studies. Significant collection areas include Florida, federal taxation of the United States, and British Commonwealth material. The Library's Joint Collection Strength holds 6 million + print volumes, 1.5 million digital pages. [9] The library also administers florida Academic Repository (FLARE), a centralized shared print storage facility that houses millions of books from florida State University System and Miami University. The Library has built several important research collections discussed above, namely the Latin American Collection, the Isser Price Library and Rae Judaica, and the Maps and Images Library. Others include the Baldwin History Children's Library of Florida, which is the state's leading Floridiana collection, holds the largest collection of Spanish colonial documents about the Southeast of the United States in North America as well as rich in archives of prominent Florida politicians, (Smathers Library, Special Collections). The library also has a very stronghold in the preservation of 18th-century American architecture (AFA), late 19th and early 20th century German state documents from 1850-1940, Latin American art and architecture, (AFA and Smathers Library), national bibliography (Smathers Library), rural Florida sociology and tropical and subtropical agricultural collections (Marston Science Library), UK and American Benefactor Senator George Smathers Libraries named after George Amathers Smathers attended University of Florida law school and served as president of the student body. He donated about \$20 million to Florida's library system in 1991, which at the time was the largest contribution to a public university in the state of Florida.
