Android Auto's BMW Android Auto was launched in 2015, and the first car manufacturer to offer it as a factory package was Hyundai. It is now available in more than 500 models of various cars makes either as a standard feature or additionally. Android Auto is a mobile app that lets you use your favorite smartphone apps on your car display. Once the Android device is connected to the car, the car screen serves as a display for the Android Auto app, adapted to the car's user interface. So you don't need to interact with your smartphone to start navigating, turn on the music or make a call. Does BMW have Android Auto as the home version of iDrive? Right now, Android Auto is supported by 47 cars does. Previously, BMW does not even plan to be among them, but in December 2019, the automaker announced its intention to install Android Auto on the next-generation BMW model. The first cars with Android Auto will be released in July 2020. Only 2019/2020 BMW models with the latest iDrive 7.0 will be equipped with this integration. If you're after a genuine BMW solution only, among the scant ways of integrating Android devices with BMW you'll find the BMW Connected app (which depends heavily on your phone and car model meaning connectivity problems and errors are inevitable), Bluetooth and a few others. If you really want to get Android Auto in BMW without installing any aftermarket hardware updates, you can run the app on your smartphone and mirror it on your iDrive screen. How can I get Android Auto in my BMW? When it comes to native integration of iDrive and Android Auto, BMW cars can be upgraded with the original BimmerTech update - Android Auto MMI Prime. What does that mean? There is no need to change your BMW system for some Android Auto head unit. You can leave your native iDrive and use BMW controls to navigate the app. You only need to install a multimedia module (MMI) that is connected to your BMW head unit. Although, it recommends the OS version, starting at 6.0 (Marshmallow) and up, for better performance. To see your Android version, go to Settings and then to the device section. Why Android Auto is not available in all countries Unfortunately, BMW Android Auto is limited at the regional level. It is currently available in 36 countries - you can find the full list here. But if you check out the Google Play store and it's not there, probably your location isn't on the list. In this case, you can make a quick decision - download the Android Auto .apk file from an alternative source on the Internet or use a VPN to change your region and download it from the Google Play Store. How do I connect to Android Auto? Wireless Connection To enjoy Android Auto wireless phone should support wireless Android Auto. As You connect it wirelessly, your phone will automatically connect to MMI every time you get your BMW, without you don't even remove the phone from your pocket or bag. USB connection In order to run Android Auto through the cable, you need to connect the Android device to the machine by plugging the USB cable into a separate USB outlet provided in the Android Auto MMI Prime kit. You can put it in any suitable location, so it's convenient for you to keep your smartphone connected. No need to keep the Android Auto app open on your smartphone. In fact, your Android device can work independently, except for calls that will go through the BMW system. How to use Android Auto in BMW? Android Auto MMI Prime works just like the original software is designed, but it's integrated with the BMW iDrive system, which has no native support for Android Auto, so it works differently than in other cars with Android Auto.
